

e) the availability of funds to install chlorination equipment.

2. That Respondent the City of Oregon be debarred from introducing at the hearing in this matter any testimony or other evidence relating to the following issues:

a) description and operation of Respondent's public water supply system;

b) modifications of said system and the cost of modification;

c) the construction, installation and cost of chlorination equipment;

d) the presence or absence of contaminants in Respondent's public water supply system;

e) the availability of funds to install chlorination equipment.
