INTERIM ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Young):

On October 12, 1976, and amended on November 24, 1976, Franklin H. Weber and Southwest Expressways filed a Motion to Dismiss Counts III and IV of the Complaint in this matter. Prior to the Board ruling on this Motion, the Board hereby requests the affected parties to submit, within 35 days, briefs on the following issues:

- A. Does any authority exist for holding an officer, director, or shareholder of a corporation personally responsible for any violation of the Environmental Protection Act that may be committed by that corporation.
- B. How can any final determination of the Board in this matter affect a corporation which evidently ceased existence in 1973 (Amend. Comp. Count I, par. 3).

In addition to the foregoing, the Board hereby stays all further proceedings in this matter until the Board rules on the issues raised herein.
