**09-12** <u>Dennis Biddle - Seaton (Property ID Num 14-14-22-300-005) v. IEPA</u> – Upon receipt of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's recommendation, the Board found and certified that petitioner's specified facilities, located in Mercer County, are pollution control facilities for the purpose of preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2006)).

**09-13** <u>People of the State of Illinois v. Behr Iron & Steel, Inc., an Illinois Corporation</u> – Upon receipt of a proposed stipulation and settlement agreements and agreed motions to request relief from the hearing requirement in this air enforcement action involving a Winnebago County facility, the Board ordered publication of the required newspaper notice.

**09-14** <u>People of the State of Illinois v. Behr Aluminum, Inc., an Illinois Corporation</u> – Upon receipt of a proposed stipulation and settlement agreements and agreed motions to request relief from the hearing requirement in this air enforcement action involving a Winnebago County facility, the Board ordered publication of the required newspaper notice.

**09-15** <u>Lafever Farms-Joy (Property Identification Number 01-02-12-200-004) v. IEPA</u> – Upon receipt of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's recommendation, the Board found and certified that petitioner's specified facilities, located in Mercer County, are pollution control facilities for the purpose of preferential tax treatment under the Property Tax Code (35 ILCS 200/11-10 (2006)).
