

of the YM-YWCA, the Agency recommends that variance from Rule 962 of Chapter 3 as it relates to Rule 602(c) and 602(d)(3) be granted provided the YM-YWCA apply for and obtain a construction permit. The Board finds no variance is necessary since the reasoning applied to the case of the City applies to the YM-YWCA as well. However, this finding does not, of course, release the YM-YWCA from the permit requirements.


This Opinion constitutes the findings of fact and conclusions of law of the Board in this matter.

1. The Variance Petition of the City of Streator is denied as moot.
2. The variance Petition by the YM-YWCA of the City of Streator is denied as moot.
