ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Satchell):

The Board proposes to revise Chapter 4: Mine Related Pollution to conform with codification regulations adopted by the Secretary of State (Ill. Rev. Stat., ch. 127, §1007; 1 Ill. Admin. Code Part 120 and §160.1101; 4 Ill. Reg. p. 196, June 27, 1980; 5 Ill. Reg. p. 178, January 2, 1981; 5 Ill. Reg. p. 694, January 16, 1981). Chapter 4 has recently been revised (R76-20, R77-10, Opinion and Order of July 24, 1980; 4 Ill. Reg. no. 34, p. 164, effective August 7, 1980).

Chapter 4 can be codified through renumbering of its Rules. The Board proposes to retain the existing structure of seven parts, which will be numbered Parts 401 through 407 of Title 35, Subtitle D: Mine Related Water Pollution, Chapter I: Pollution Control Board. Part 406 (old Part VI) will be split into two subparts. Old Rule 605.1 will be numbered Section 406.201 and moved to Subpart b: Site Specific Effluent and Water Quality Standards; Temporary Rules.

A draft copy of Subtitle D, Chapter I has been prepared. Because the changes are slight and the text lengthy, the Board will not set it forth in this Order or print the draft in the Opinions. The Board will provide notice of its intent to codify old Chapter 4 in the Environmental Register. Copies will be mailed to persons on the R76-20, R77-10 mailing list and to anyone requesting a copy. Persons desiring to comment may do so within thirty days of the date of this Order.

The Secretary of State's Rules provide a method for codification of rules without substantive changes (1 Ill. Admin. Code §160.1103). The Board proposes to follow this abbreviated procedure. The Board will at this time submit a copy of the draft to the State Library for approval. The Board will consider comments and the State Library's recommendation prior to adopting a declaration that no substantive changes have been made (1 Ill. Admin. Code §160.1103).
