Notice of Petition by Maximum Investments, LLC for an Adjusted Standard before the Illinois Pollution Control Board  
Maximum Investments, LLC (Maximum) - 9437 Karlov, Skokie, IL 60076 submitted a petition to the Illinois Pollution Control Board (PCB) for an adjusted standard from 35 Illinois Administrative Code 740.210(a)3 regarding the written approval of the property owner for an application to the Site Remediation Program. The initial filing of the petition was received by the PCB on November 7, 2008 and issued Case Number AS 2009-002. The subject property is part of the Stoney Creek Landfill located at 10900 S 84th St, Palos Hills, IL, PIN # 23-14-400-026. The property is a former landfill abandoned since the early 1970's. The prior owner filed for bankruptcy in the 1970's and is now believed to be deceased. Maximum holds a tax lien on the property and wishes to enroll the property in the Site Remediation Program. Maximum seeks an adjusted standard in the form of the requirements of section 740.210(a)3 requiring the written permission of the property owner for conducting investigative and remedial activities is hereby waived with regards to the subject property.  
Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above described adjusted standard proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the adjusted standard proceeding, as found in this notice, and must be mailed to the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 W Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, IL 60601.  
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
