

CONCURRING OPINION (by Mr. Dumelle):

The data show two "violations" of the oxidant standard during the August 1-4, 1975 temporary monitoring period. A case can be made that one of these "violations" was not really a violation since it was exactly at the 0.08 ppm standard and technically this only "equalled" but did not "exceed" the standard.

Regardless of this argument, I would have voted to deny the variance because of the great number of oxidant violations in the Chicago Major Metropolitan Area in which this source is located. The emissions are in the same "airshed" where the oxidant problem has been widespread and frequent.
