ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning)

On October 4, 1999, pursuant to Section 31.1(b) of the Environmental Protection Act (Act) (415 ILCS 5/31.1(b) (1998)), the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) issued an administrative citation to John Simpson. The administrative citation alleges that the respondent violated Sections 21(p)(1) and 21(p)(7)(i) of the Act. 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1), 21(p)(7)(i) (1998). The alleged violations occurred at a facility located in Cumberland County, Illinois, commonly known to the Agency as Neoga/John Simpson.

On November 4, 1999, respondent filed a petition for review of the administrative citation pursuant to Section 31.1(d) of the Act. (415 ILCS 5/31.1(d) (1998) The Board accepts this matter for hearing. The Board reminds respondent that, after hearing, any person found to have violated the Act as alleged in the administrative citation is liable to pay a penalty under Section 42 (b)(4) of the Act of \$500 per violation, as well as any hearing costs incurred by the Board or the complainant. 415 ILCS 42(b)(4) (1998).

The Board directs that this matter proceed to hearing as expeditiously as practicable. The assigned hearing officer must set the matter for hearing in accordance with the requirements of the Act and the Board's procedural rules.
