ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

On March 29, 1979, the Board consolidated the above-captioned proceedings. On May 17, 1979, the Board conducted the last hearing on the study done by the Institute of Natural Resources on the economic impact of R78-10 and R78-11. At that hearing, the Hearing Officer, noting that it was possible the Board would sever R79-3 from R78-10 and R78-11, set June 11, 1979, as the final date for submitting public comments on R78-10 and R78-11.

The Board has still not received the complete economic impact study of R79-3. Therefore, in the interest of avoiding undue delay in reaching a decision on R78-10 and R78-11 and in submitting a final regulation to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for inclusion in the Illinois State Implementation Plan, the Board hereby severs R79-3 from R78-10 and R78-11. R78-10 and R78-11 shall remain consolidated. However, we hereby extend the public comment period on these consolidated proceedings to and including June 18, 1979.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
