

ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.A. Manning):

This matter is before the Board on Citizens Utilities of Illinois' (Citizens) January 12, 1996 motion to dismiss the instant rulemaking proceeding docketed as R81-19. The motion provides that Citizens has reached a settlement agreement with the USEPA in a related federal enforcement action resulting in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) issuing a revised NPDES permit covering Citizens West Suburban Waste Water Treatment Plant No. 1 located in the Village of Bolingbrook. Citizens states that the Agency's issuance of the permit renders this rulemaking docket moot and that it no longer wishes to proceed in this matter. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed and the docket is hereby closed.¹
