ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Goodman):

On October 24, 1977 the authority to administer the NPDES program in the State of Illinois was transferred to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. This action activated sub-part A of Part 9 and Rules 410(a), 410(b) and 501(c) and 704 of Chapter 3 of the Board's Rules and Regulations. Since the subject matter of proposed Regulation R76-4 is the effective date of sub-part A of Chapter 3 of the Board's Regulations, the proposed Regulation has become moot and is therefore dismissed.
