ORDER OF THE BOARD (by D. Satchell):

On November 14, 1980 McLean County Service Company (McLean) filed a petition to join additional parties respondent in this enforcement case. The complaint alleges violations resulting from discharge of fertilizer solution from a tank owned by McLean. The motion seeks to add as parties the manufacturer and vendor of a valve which failed on the tank. The complaint filed by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency does not allege violations by these persons; they are therefore not proper parties respondent. To the extent the motion may be construed as a request for leave to file a third party complaint, the Board does not allow such (Owens-Illinois, Inc. v. IEPA, PCB 77-288, 29 PCB 85, January 19, 1978; IEPA v. Giachini, PCB 77-143, 33 PCB 547, May 24, 1979; IEPA v. Carlstrom, PCB 78-153, 34 PCB 47, June 22, 1979). McLean may file a separate complaint against these persons pursuant to Section 31(b) of the Environmental Protection Act and Part III of the Procedural Rules. The motion is denied.
