**ALAN L. JIRIK'S RESPONSE  
TO QUESTION RAISED AT HEARING**

NOW Comes Corn Products International, Inc. ("Corn Products), by and through its attorneys, HODGE DWYER & DRIVER, and submits the following Response to a Question Raised at Hearing from Alan L. Jirik.

**Alan L. Jirik's Response**

At hearing on July 28, 2009, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") asked if water received from the Village of Bedford Park ("Bedford Park") at Corn Products' Argo Plant ("Argo") is discharged exclusively to the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago ("MWRDGC"). At the hearing I testified that I believed that Bedford Park water used by Corn Products was only discharged to MWRDGC and not to the Chicago Sanitary and Ship Canal ("Sanitary & Ship Canal"). However, I agreed to follow up my answer by reviewing Argo operations.

At the time of the Pollution Control Board hearing on July 28, 2009, Corn Products had not discharged water from Bedford Park to the Sanitary & Ship Canal, but it had the capability and authorization from Illinois EPA to do so. From the period of July 28, 2009 to October 20, 2009, Corn Products discharged water from Bedford Park to

the Sanitary & Ship Canal on five separate days at an average flow rate of 0.26 million gallons per day. In the future, Corn Products may choose to discharge Bedford Park water to the Sanitary & Ship Canal when conditions favoring this occur. Therefore, discharges of Bedford Park water to the Sanitary & Ship Canal are likely to occur at irregular intervals.

Along with this Response, Corn Products is also filing Joseph V. Idaszak's Response to a Question Raised at Hearing. In addition, Corn Products plans to file James E. Huff's Response to Questions Raised at Hearing, but Mr. Huff must await MWRDGC's response to an information request before finalizing his Response. Upon receipt of the requested information, Corn Products will file Mr. Huff's Response.

NOW Comes Corn Products International, Inc. ("Corn Products), by and through its attorneys, HODGE DWYER & DRIVER, and submits the following Response to a Question Raised at Hearing from Joseph V. Idaszak.

**Joseph V. Idaszak's Response**

At hearing on July 28, 2009, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("Illinois EPA") asked how I determined that the cost of installing cooling equipment was unreasonable. My opinion is based on the high cost of installing and operating a cooling tower and mechanical cooling system in conjunction with testimony offered by Mr. Huff that aquatic ecosystems would receive negligible environmental benefit if Corn Products cooled its discharge to meet the proposed standards. I believe a cost that neither improves production nor meaningfully benefits environmental conditions is unreasonable.
