ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed May 9, 1974 is inadequate in that the reasons for delay in meeting the Board Rules and Regulations are not given. Furthermore, the alternative of more frequent soot-blowing to offset the alleged higher rate of ash deposition on heat transfer surfaces (p. 3 of Petition) is not explored.

Petitioner is ordered to provide further information as detailed above within 45 days from the date of this order. Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing the additional information.
