ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G.T. Girard):

On January 12, 2010, Dynegy Midwest Generation, Inc. (DMG) timely appealed a December 9, 2009 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency) concerning DMG's two electricity-generating coal-fired boilers, located at #1 Chessen Lane in Alton, Madison County. In the determination, the Agency issued a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to DMG with a limitation of 1 milligram per liter of boron effluent. Following DMG's appeal, DMG and the Agency arrived at mutually agreeable limitations for discharges of boron, and on May 19, 2010, DMG filed a motion to voluntarily withdraw the petition for review. The Board grants the motion and closes this docket.
