### VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Jan Mier during the course of her June 10, 2010 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in used tires, at this site, not altered, covered or otherwise prevented from accumulating water, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2008).

### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than August 30, 2010, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each

violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2008), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS  
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2008). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.


Affiant, *Jan Mier*, being first duly sworn, voluntarily deposes and states as follows:

On June 10, 2010, I conducted an inspection at the above-referenced site located at 1600 Wall Street in Beardstown, IL. I was in Beardstown for another inspection and wanted to see if Belville's was handling their used tires and other waste correctly, since I hadn't been by there since 2006. The business is operated by Larry G. Belville, and Bradley Alan Fox. The property is owned by joint tenants, Larry G. and Pauline Belville, and Bradley Alan Fox and Michelle Fox (see attached property deed). The business, Belville's Garage, LLC, is in "involuntary dissolution" per the attached IL Secretary of State Corporation File Detail Report.

I arrived at 1:50 p.m. and drove around behind the garage. There I observed a farm truck with slatted sides filled with used on rim tires (see photo #001). Many of the used tires held water such as shown in photo #004 and #005. Used off rim tires were scattered on the ground as well (see photo #002). These also held water (see photo #003).

Hundreds of pallets were stacked on site (see photo #006). 20- 30 used vehicles were also in back of the building (see photo #007). Partially filled drums were on the south side of the building (see photo #008). Some were marked "used oil", some were not. A heavily saturated patch of soil is shown in photo #009. More drums and stained soil were on the east side of the parking lot (see photo #010). Additional pallets were also stacked nearby.


I went inside the office. Two men were sitting at a table and a woman was behind the counter. After some questioning, one of the men admitted to being Mr. Beleville. I told him about the used tires out back that held water and that the legislature had passed a law that carried a \$1,500.00 fine for allowing water in used tires. He said there weren't any tires in back. I said I had photos of them. I asked who removes the waste tires. He said the City of Beardstown used to come and get them when they had an Illinois EPA used tire collection. This is not legal because businesses are not allowed into the collections and the City of Beardstown is not an Illinois EPA registered used tire hauler. He said they used to take them to Pherigo Salvage in Chandlerville, IL, but they no longer accepted them. He said he didn't know where to take them. At this point Brad Fox came into the office. I repeated to him what I had told Mr. Belville. He also said he didn't know where to take them. I told him I would send them a list of Illinois EPA registered used tire haulers. He said they did not sell very many used tires. I departed at 2:20 p.m.

Violations observed during the inspection are noted on the attached checklist.

On June 14, 2010, I telephoned Brad Fox and asked him to send me the last two disposal tickets for their waste tires. He said they had been taking them to the Beardstown WalMart, but the new store did not handle tires, so they have been sitting there. I asked when the last time he took them to WalMart and he said probably a year ago. I told him he must dispose of waste tires at least every 90 days. I gave him the names and numbers of a few IEPA registered tire haulers. I asked where all the pallets had come from and he said they took them to burn in their burner in the winter. I said he must not do this, but I later learned that pallets can be burned for fuel inside of a device such as a heater. They cannot be open burned for disposal purposes. I asked what he did with the used oil they generated and he said they also burned that. I asked about their parts washer and he said Safety Kleen came and serviced it. I asked about the used vehicles in back. He said those were waiting for salvage titles so they could be crushed. I asked who crushed the autos and he said D&D Auto Crushers. He said they did not allow tires to be put into the vehicles. I told him most salvage yards now let several used tires to be placed in the vehicles.

I looked at their file and on 11/28/06 I had conducted an inspection and a Violation Notice dated 1/10/07 had been sent. In that letter, Belville's Garage had been told they must remove waste to an Illinois EPA permitted landfill, including oil stained soil. They were also told to label all used oil containers and to prevent water from accumulating in all used tires.




