This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008).

#### **FACTS**

- 1. That Luke Marquard, Jr. is the current owner and operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 400 Marnico Road, located northwest of Jacksonville, Morgan County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Road District No.6\Marquard.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1378065004.
  - 3. That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on August 8, 2010, Steven Townsend of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Springfield Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 9-30-70, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7007 0220 0000 0152 3571.

#### VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Steven Townsend during the course of his August 9, 2010 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2008).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in Deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris: or Clean Construction or Demolition Debris a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2008).

#### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>October 18, 2010</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008), and if the Illinois

Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2008), if Respondent fails to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

# PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2008). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

#### **Inspection Narrative**

A complaint about this property at 400 Marnico Rd., located northwest of Jacksonville, IL, that alleged open dumping and burning had previously been received on March 16, 2007 (C-07-096-C). An inspection conducted on March 20, 2007 resulted in an Administrative Citation Warning Notice (ACWN) being sent to the property owner, and site operator, Mr. Luke Marquard, Jr., on April 5, 2007. A re-inspection was conducted on February 18, 2009 at which time the facility was found to have returned to compliance.

Another complaint was received on June 7, 2010, alleging that Luke Marquard, Jr. had dumped and burned waste from demolishing mobile homes brought in from off-site. Another inspection by this author was conducted based on the June 7, 2010, complaint. I arrived at the above referenced facility at 10:30 on August 9, 2010. I spoke with Kim Manley. She and William Allen live at the site. Ms. Manley stated that they only rent the place and that the mobile home waste was from the owner, Mr. Marquard, who owns and runs a mobile home park. Ms. Manley stated that there had been no burning of this waste, only some brush from on the property. Mr. Allen was not home when I interviewed Ms. Manley.

I inspected the facility and found open dumped wastes, predominantly from mobile homes, present (see photos 1378065005~08092010-001 through 003, 005, 006, 008 through 013 and 015). In addition to the mobile home wastes, used tires (see photos 1378065005~08092010-005 through 007), white goods (see photos 1378065005~08092010-014 and 015), and a waste car/vehicle parts (see photos 1378065005~08092010-018 and 019) were also on site. A mobile home apparently used for storage of parts was also on-site (see photos 1378065005~08092010-001 and 017). The former (2007) burn pile location appeared not to have had mobile home waste burned there. Some remnants of charred brush were seen in this location (see photo 1378065005~08092010-004).

While inspecting the site Mr. William Allen arrived. I also interviewed Mr. Allen. He reiterated that no burning of this waste had occurred. He also concurred that the waste was from Mr. Marquard's business and that the wastes were not from him or Ms. Manley. Mr. Allen also said that Mr. Marquard was slowly getting rid of the wastes and that he had contacted Buster Sanitation (Area Disposal), a local trash hauler. A small dumpster was already on-site (see photos 1378065005~08092010-015 and 016). I left the site at 11:30

Apparent violations are noted in the attached checklist.


