ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed January 31, 1974 is inadequate in that no environmental effects are given of the increased particulate emissions were coal to be burned 100% as is requested.


Also no showing is made that the Agency has denied the City of Mascoutah's request for a new operating permit. No compliance program to meet particulate emission standards is given.

Petitioner is ordered to amend the petition within 45 days from the date of this order to supply the information listed above. A waiver of the 90-day decision period shall be filed from the date of the filing of the original variance petition until the date of the filing of the amended variance petition.

Failure to timely file the amended petition shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy.
