ORDER OF THE BOARD (BY SAMUEL T. LAWTON, JR.):

We have received a petition by the Home Builders Association of Illinois and signed by over 200 persons, together with memorandum of facts in support of the proposed regulation, proposing the adoption of a Rule 604 which would require, in effect, that when sewage treatment facilities reach 80% of capacity, sewage treatment plant operators would propose a plan for improving capacity of the facility and that said plan would be implemented when the facility reaches 90% of its capacity. The submission satisfies the statutory requirements for consideration of a regulation and, accordingly, hearing will be set on the proposed regulation consolidated with pending #R71-19 in matter of: Sewer Connection Bans.
