HEARING OFFICER ORDER

On March 18, 2010, the Board granted a motion filed by the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (District) for additional hearing to address aquatic life uses and the District's Habitat Reports. In addition, participants have requested an opportunity to present testimony and evidence concerning the economic impact of the proposed aquatic life uses. Today hearings are set to address both the economic impact and the District's Habitat Reports. The testimony will begin with the economic impact and then proceed to the District's Habitat Reports.

All testimony must be prefiled by February 2, 2011, and prefiled questions must be filed by February 23, 2011. The mailbox rule does not apply. A prehearing conference may be held at a date to be determined later to establish the order of witnesses and questioners.
