JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois

Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. Seq., specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

1. The Respondent, Joseph Melvin, is the present owner; and occupies and is in control and possession of a facility located in the County of Perry, State of Illinois.

2. The facility is an open dump and designated with the Site Code #1458335003. The

facility is known to the Agency as the DuQuoin/Joseph Melvin site.

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3. The Respondent has owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.

4. On October 28, 2010, Rebecca Tracy, Field Inspector, Perry County Solid Waste

Department, Inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms.

Tracy's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIOLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector, Rebecca Tracy's, direct observation, she has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on October 28, 2010, an on-site inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

The Respondent has caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS
5/21(p)(1).

2. The Respondent has caused or allowed the deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction debris at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(p) (7).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than February 28, 2011, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violations(s) as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation(s) as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

(1) Perry County Solid Waste, c/o Perry County Treasurer, Perry County Government Building, 3764 State Route 13/127, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274; and,

(2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, PO Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a Petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review shall also be filed with David Stanton, State's Attorney, Perry County Courthouse, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274. Your Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation. Your petition must state the reason(s) you believe the present matter should not be issued. If you fail to file your petition and state the reasons the present matter should not be issued, a default order against you will be entered by the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Your original Petition must be filed with the Clerk of the Board at:

On October 28, 2010, an inspection was performed at the above-referenced location. This inspection was made as a follow up regarding open dumping occurring on this property. Weather conditions were approximately 65 degrees, sunny and slightly windy.

The information obtained from the Perry County Assessor's Office indicates that the property is owned by Joseph Melvin. The site address is 1169 Old DuQuoin Road, DuQuoin, IL 62832. The property record card identifies this property as parcel number 1-61-0340-190. in Section 22, Township 06, Range 01. It is further described as part of the SE half of the NW half of Section 22, Township 06, Range 01 and contains .50 acres.

To arrive at the site, take Old DuQuoin Road south at the intersection of Old DuQuoin Road and Jackson Street. The property is about .25 miles south of Lively Subdivision and sites on the West side of the road. The GIS coordinates indicate 38°01.869N and 089°14.333W with an accuracy of 108 feet.

I arrived at the site at 12:10 p.m. I walked and photographed the site.

Photos 001 through 004 depict the areas of the property as you enter it from the driveway. The areas are covered with construction/demolition debris, white goods, used/waste tires and refuse and debris. At the time of the inspection all the items were open dumped on the ground, with the exception of some of the debris pictured in Photo 001, which is stored on a wooden structure; however, the items are being stored out in the open and not being protected from the elements for any future use. None of the items were in use and/or usable in their current condition; nor, were they being stored in such a way as to protect them for any future use. The used/waste tires were open dumped on the ground and not being stored in such a way that would prevent them from holding precipitation. The white goods are being stored out in the elements and not being protected for future use.

Photos 005 through 012 depict the inner area of the property. The area is covered with construction/demolition debris, plumbing waste, pipes, scrap, used/waste tires, refuse and debris, and white goods. Photo 009 depicts not only construction debris and scrap, but also a gutted and stripped trailer, which is being used to store additional refuse and debris; however, all the windows are out of the trailer and portions of the trailer have been removed so that the items being stored in the trailer are not being stored in such a manner as to protect them from the elements or for any future use. None of the debris was in use and/or useable in its current condition; nor, were they being stored in a manner that would protect them for any future use.

Photos 013 and 014 depict piles of used/waste tires which are open dumped on the ground and are not being stored in a manner which would prevent them from holding precipitation. It is estimated that there are at least 100 used/waste tires depicted Photos 013 and 014.

Photos 015 and 016 depict areas in the inner portion of the property. The areas are covered with debris, refuse and construction/demolition debris. The items are open dumped on the ground, are not being used and/or usable in their current condition and are not being stored in such a manner as to protect them for any future use.

Photos 017 and 018 depict the outside of the gutted, stripped trailer from the outside of the property. There is refuse, debris and construction/demolition debris open dumped in the area which is not in use and/or not usable in its current condition and is not being stored in such a manner as to protect it for any future use.

Photos 019 and 020 depict additional tires and scrap open dumped on the property. The items are not in use and/or usable in their current condition and are not being stored in such a manner as to protect them for any future use. The tires are open dumped on the ground and are not being stored in a manner which would prevent them from holding precipitation.

Photos 021 through 025 depict additional areas of the property where refuse, debris and construction/demolition debris have been open dumped on the ground. These items are not in use and/or usable in their current condition and are not being stored in such a manner as to protect them for any future use.

Almost the entire .50 acres is littered with debris and refuse of various forms; further, it is estimated that there are 200 used/waste tires open dumped on the property.

My inspection ended at approximately 12:25 p.m.
