ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle):

Petition filed August 19, 1974 is inadequate in that it does not give the sewer to which the property at 2803 Blanchard Road would be tributary nor does it tell when that sewer would be made adequate in transport capacity by the City of Waukegan or any other agency. Also no data are given as to family income or rentals paid upon which a hardship judgment can be made.

Petitioner shall file an amended petition within 45 days. Failure to timely file the needed information shall make the petition liable to dismissal for inadequacy. The 90-day decision period set by statute shall run from the date of filing the additional information. The amended petition shall be filed with both the Board and the Environmental Protection Agency.
