COMPLAINT

The ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, complaining of the CITY

OF SPRINGFIELD and SPRINGFIELD CITY WATER, LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY,

states:

- 1. On July 29 and 30, 1970, the CITY OF SPRINGFIELD and SPRINGFIELD CITY WATER, LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY were observed to be emitting smoke from the Springfield City Water, Light and Power Company "Lakeside" and "Dallman" plants in violation of Rule 3-3.122 of the Rules and Regulations Governing the Control of Air Pollution, effective pursuant to Section 49 (c) of the Environmental Protection Act.
- 2. On July 29 and 30, 1970, the CITY OF SPRINGFIELD and SPRINGFIELD CITY WATER, LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY were observed to be causing air pollution in violation of Section 9 (a) of the Environmental Protection Act.

WHEREFORE: (A) The ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY asks that a date be set for a hearing, not less than 21 days from the date of service of

this Complaint, before a hearing officer designated by this Board, at which time
the CITY OF SPRINGFIELD and SPRINGFIELD CITY WATER, LIGHT AND POWER
COMPANY be required to answer the allegations of this Complaint.

(B) The ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY asks for the entry of an order directing the CITY OF SPRINGFIELD and SPRINGFIELD CITY WATER, LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY to cease and desist the aforesaid violations, and for the assessment of a penalty in the amount of \$10,000, plus \$1,000 for each day such violation shall be shown to have continued.
