On June 15, 2011, Ziggy Development, LLC (Ziggy) filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss this appeal, which concerns a leaking underground storage tank (UST) site located at a facility formerly known as Midwest Illinois Auto and Truck Plaza at Illinois Route 127 and Interstate 70 in Greenville, Bond County. Ziggy had filed a petition for review of a determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency regarding Ziggy's proposed High Priority Corrective Action Budget Amendment for the leaking UST site. The Board grants Ziggy's motion for voluntary dismissal, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
