ORDER OF THE BOARD (by G. T. Girard):

On July 20, 2011, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Shell Oil Products U.S. (SOPUS) may appeal a June 16, 2011 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). See 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency stated that the proposals addressing investigative activities associated with corrective action efforts for contaminated groundwater and free product can be approved with certain conditions and modifications stipulated by the Agency for the oil refinery, WRB Refining, LLC Wood River Refinery, located at 900 South Central Avenue, P.O. Box 76, Roxana, Madison County.

The Board extends the appeal period until October 24, 2011, as the parties request. See 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If SOPUS fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
