



JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008).

FACTS

1. That Ashwin P. and Mita A. Patel are the current owners and operators ("Respondents") of a facility located at 1406 Broeking Road, Marion, Williamson County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Marion/Patel, Ashwin P & Mita A.
2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1990555228.
3. That Respondents have owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
4. That on August 17, 2011, Maggie Stevenson and Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-

described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 9-14-11, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7004 2510 0001 8588 4069

#### VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Maggie Stevenson and Garrison Gross during the course of the August 17, 2011 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2008).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3) (2008).
- (3) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in Deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris: or Clean Construction or Demolition Debris a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2008).

### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than October 31, 2011, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2008), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS  
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2008). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

### **General Remarks**

This inspection was made as the result of a complaint received by this office. Inspector Gross accompanied me on the site inspection. The inspection began at approximately 10:05 a.m. and concluded around 10:30 a.m. Fifteen pictures were taken at the site. Open burning had occurred at the site in more than one location.


**Inspection Findings:** Waste had been transported onto the site and open dumped in numerous locations. Among the waste (but not limited to) were 14 drums labeled as high fructose syrup, commercial furniture, commercial lighting fixtures, toilets, lavatories, box springs, mattresses, lamp shades, bed frames, commercial laundry equipment, patio furniture, ceramic tile, nursery lights, tires off rims, and carpet padding (pictures 001-004, 006, 012-015). Various metals, electronics, and miscellaneous waste were also strewn throughout the area. The burn pile on the north side of the north barn consisted of roofing, dimensional lumber, rebar, and domicile waste (picture 005). The ash at this burn site was dark and compacted, giving the appearance of an older burn pile. A sealed drum, not labeled, and in very poor condition was located in the same area (picture 005). The burn pile west of the center barn consisted of charred box springs, mattress springs, and various metals (pictures 007-011). This burn pile was still smoldering at the time of the inspection (pictures 009 and 010). I briefly spoke with a man who identified himself as Ashwin Patel's father. He stated that Ashwin Patel was at work and no one else was at home. I requested that his son give me a call if he had any questions regarding the inspection and handed him my card.

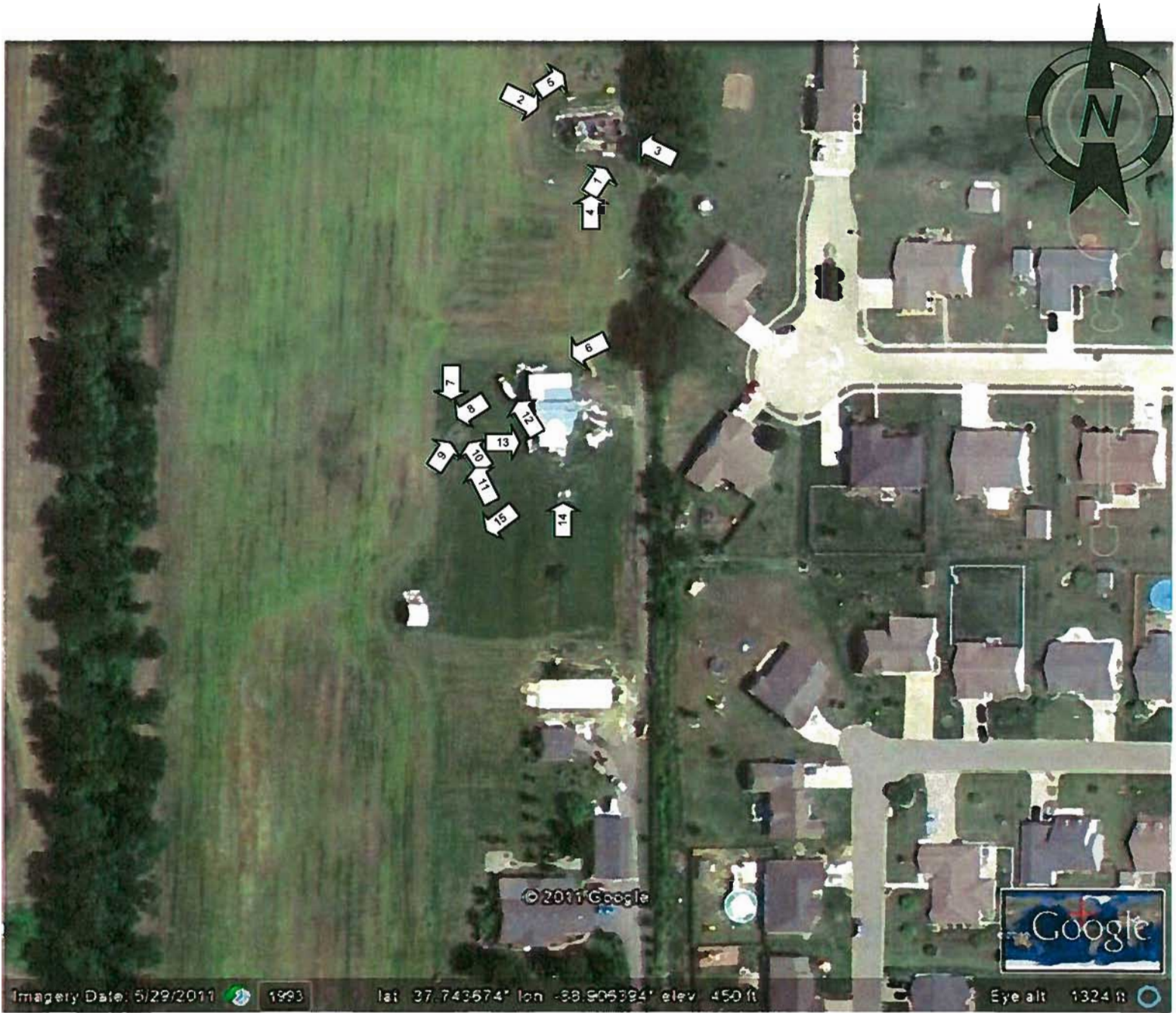
**Additional Remarks:** This property is adjacent to a subdivision and is located within Marion city limits. The Marion Fire Department responded to a call regarding a barn on fire at the Patel property on 8/12/2011. According to the report, Mr. Patel was advised of the city burn ordinance. The report indicates that brush was ignited by a man and the fire was allowed to burn out. The Williamson County Tax Assessor's Office identified Ashwin and Mita Patel as owners of numerous properties in Marion, some being commercial.

### **Summary of Violations:**

1. Open dumping of waste;
2. Open burning of waste;
3. Conducting waste storage and disposal operations without a permit;
4. Open dumping of tires; and
5. Failure to submit an application for permit to develop and operate a landfill.


