- The Respondent, Ronald Hammel, is the present owner; and is in control and possession
 of a facility located in the County of Perry, State of Illinois.
- 2. The facility is an open dump and designated with the Site Code #1450105087. The facility is known to the Agency as the DuQuoin/Ronald Hammel site.
- 3. The Respondent has owned, occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.
- 4. On August 23, 2011, Rebecca Tracy, Field Inspector, Perry County Solid Waste

 Department, inspected the facility. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms.

 Tracy's affidavit, are attached and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit A.

VIQLATIONS

On the basis of Field Inspector, Rebecca Tracy's, direct observation, she has determined that the Respondent has caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner that resulted in the following violations:

That on August 23, 2011, an on-site inspection of the facility disclosed the following:

The Respondent has caused or allowed litter at the facility in violation of 415 ILCS
 5/21(p)(1).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than January 2, 2012, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution

Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2006), and if the Illinois

Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violations(s) as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing,

Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental

Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in

addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and a finding of violation(s) as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, checks shall be made payable in equal amounts (50% of total penalty each) to:

(1) Perry County Solid Waste, c/o Perry County Treasurer, Perry County Government Building, 3764 State Route 13/127, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274; and,

(2) Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, PO Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276.

Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Forms with payments to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Complainant may initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court or other debt collection actions to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with 415 ILCS 5/31.1. If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a Petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review shall also be filed with David Searby, Assistant State's Attorney, Perry County Courthouse, Pinckneyville, Illinois 62274. Your Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation. Your petition must state the reason(s) you believe the present matter should not be issued. If you fail to file your petition and state the reasons the present matter should not be issued, a default order against you will be entered by the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

On August 23, 2011, an inspection was performed at the above-referenced location. This inspection was made as a follow up regarding open dumping occurring on this property. Weather conditions were approximately 85 degrees and sunny.

The property is owned by Ronald Hammel whose resides at 7949 State Route 14, DuQuoin, IL 62832; however, the property address is 457 State Route 51, DuQuoin, IL. This parcel is identified as parcel number 1-61-0490-230 containing 1.30 acres in Part of the NE WE of Section 32 of Township 6-1.

To arrive at the site, take Route 51 South of DuQuoin and the site is located approximately ¼ of a mile south of the intersection of Route 51 South and Route 14, on the west (right) side of the road. The GIS coordinates indicate 37°57.808N and 089°14.030W.

I arrived at the site at 1:02 p.m. I walked and photographed the site.

Photos 001 through 012 depict the property. From approximately the middle of property to the west property line, the property is covered with junk vehicles, vehicle parts, scrap, debris and used/waste tires. There are also several piles of scrap and debris located at the front half of the property. Almost all the scrap and debris is open dumped on the ground. The scrap and debris is not being in such a way as to protect it for any future use. It is estimated that there are in excess of 150 used/waste tires located on the property. Junk vehicles are being used to store scrap and debris.

Prior to ending the inspection Ronald Hammel arrived at the site and I conversed with him regarding the inspection.

I left the site at 1:28 p.m.




