COME NOW, RON BRIGHT d/b/a Quarter Construction & IRONHUSTLER EXCAVATING, INC., by their undersigned attorney, and for their respective answers to the above entitled Complaint, state as follows:

#### Counts I & III

Counts I and III make no claim against Respondents RON BRIGHT d/b/a Quarter Construction & IRONHUSTLER EXCAVATING, INC., and no response is offered thereto.

#### Count II

## (against RON BRIGHT \_\_\_\_ a Quarter Construction)

1-20. Respondent RON BRIGHT d/b/a Quarter Construction (hereinafter "Bright") has no knowledge whatever concerning the matters asserted in Paragraphs 1-20 of

the Complaint, lacks any information which would place him in a position to admit or deny same, and therefore demands strict proof thereof.

- 22. Respondent Bright admits that EPA has visited his site, and otherwise denies the allegations of Paragraph 21 of the Complaint in that the "material" referenced in the Complaint is recycled aggregate laden soil being beneficially re-used by Bright as road base. Bright further denies that any "material" has been disposed of at his site or that he is operating a landfill.
- 23. Respondent denies the allegations of Paragraph 23.
- 24. Respondent denies the allegations of Paragraph 24.

WHEREFORE, Respondent RON BRIGHT dlb/a Quarter Construction prays for the following relief:

- A. That this matter be dismissed as to him with prejudice.
- B. That he be awarded his reasonable attorney's fees and costs.

#### Count IV

#### (against IRONHUSTLER EXCAVATING, INC.)

- 1-5. Respondent IRONHUSTLER EXCAVATING, INC. (hereinafter "Ironhustler") has no knowledge whatever concerning the matters asserted in Paragraphs 1-5 of the Complaint, lacks any information which would place it in a position to admit or deny same, and therefore demands strict proof thereof.
  - 6. Ironhustler denies the allegations of Paragraph 6 insofar as the term "miscellaneous material" is used to identify what is in fact the native riverfront soil

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at the Altivity site, whose high aggregate content, as reported to Ironhustler by the general contractor, rendered it unsuitable for foundation support.

- 7. On information and belief, Ironhustler believes the information contained in Paragraph 7 is true and therefore admits same.

WHEREFORE, Respondent IRONHUSTLER EXCAVATING, INC. prays for the following relief:

- B. That it be awarded its reasonable attorney's fees and costs.
