This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq. (1996), specifically 415 ILCS 5/31.1.

FACTS

 Complainant, County of DuPage, is a unit of local government to which the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has delegated authority to issue administrative citations pursuant to Section 4(r) of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, ("Act"), 415 ILCS 5/4(r)
 (2007). DuPage County is thus a "delegated unit" and may issue administrative citations under 35 Ill. Adm. Code 108.200.

2. The Respondents, Dale A. Turek and Ronald J. Turek, are the present occupants and in control and possession of the property at 424 36th Street, Downers Grove, located in the County of DuPage, State of Illinois.

3. The property is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit, and designated with the Site Code #0438025029. The facility is known to the County as the Turek site.

4. The Respondents have occupied, controlled and/or operated the facility at all relevant times hereto.

5. On August 31, 2011, Joy Hinz, Field Inspector for DuPage County as delegated by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the property. A true and correct copy of the inspection report, along with Ms. Hinz's affidavit, are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Based upon direct observations made by Ms. Hinz during the course of her inspection,
 DuPage County has determined that Respondent violated the Act as follows:

Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, in violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2007).

Based upon the foregoing facts, under Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00).

Notices and Instructions to Respondent

- 1. You must pay the civil penalty set forth above unless you contest this Administrative Citation. The following paragraphs contain payment instructions and more information about contesting this Administrative Citation.
- 2. To pay the civil penalty (and any other amounts due) send two (2) checks or money orders with the attached Remittance Form, one check in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars payable to DuPage County and the second

- 4. Any Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation on you. The Board will not review the Administrative Citation if the Petition for Review is not filed within this time.

- 8. If you contest this Administrative Citation by filing a timely petition for review with the Board, the Board will hold a hearing. The Board's procedural rules have more information on hearings; see 35 Ill. Adm. Code Parts 101 and 108.
- 9. If the Board finds after the hearing that you committed a violation as alleged above, you will be assessed the hearing costs incurred by the County of DuPage and the Board. Hearing costs are assessed in addition to the statutory civil penalty for the violations. If the Board finds after the hearing that you did not commit a violation as alleged above, or that the violation resulted from uncontrollable circumstances, you will not be assessed hearing costs and you will not have to pay a civil penalty.
- 10. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, interest on the amount due will be assessed against you from the date payment is due and including the date that payment is received.
- 11. If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time set by the Board in its final order, the Office of the Illinois Attorney General and/or the City of Chicago Department of Law may initiate court proceedings against you to collect the amount due, plus any interest accrued. In that event, you may also be liable for court costs.

General Remarks

Pre-Inspection Notes: This site was issued Violation Notice, L-2003-DP2012 on January 10, 2003. Violations of 21(a), 21(d)(1), 21(d)(2), 21(e), 21(p)(1), 55(a)(1)of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act and 812.101 of Title 35, Subtitle G of the Illinois Administrative Code were alleged. Illinois EPA remove the tires from the site. DuPage County also cited violations of the Zoning Ordinance for vehicles and storage of junk & debris. The County worked with the property owners Ron and Dale Turek and compliance was eventually achieved.

In April 2007, Code Enforcement again identified junk & debris and vehicles being improperly stored at the property. A case was filed in for the alleged violations. Subsequent inspections by Code Enforcement identified potential violations of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act.

I conducted this inspection with Deborah Houdek, Code Enforcement Officer, to review the site for fluorescent tubes, waste tires and other miscellaneous waste. After arriving, we walked the northern property. There were vehicles, bags of aluminum cans, textiles, orange fencing, a hose and other debris stored on the driveway (Photos 1 & 2). North of the driveway there was more abandoned household debris including but not limited to chests, a cooler, a metal dolly, a dilapidated wagon, pieces of metal and a license plate (Photos 3&4).

I then reviewed the area north of the house. There was a pile of more than 20 fluorescent tubes stacked on other debris dumped on the site (Photo 5). Also in this area was more household debris including but not limited to a solvent container, a bucket of wires, commercial type light fixtures, lawn equipment and a laundry basket (Photo 6). There were several containers filled with stained water and pieces of electrical equipment including older lighting ballasts open dumped (Photo 7). There were also metal chairs, a fan, a vending type machine, refuse containers and other items abandoned on the site (Photo 8). I also observed a compressed oxygen tank lying on top of debris at the site (Photo 9). Three dilapidated boxes of cell phone charging units had been open dumped on the ground north of the house (Photo 10).

I continued westward where there was a bench with several containers of cleaning materials and a pile of bicycle tires and three waste tires (Photos 10&11). The tires were off the rim and there was standing water inside of them. There were several lawn mowers and other items abandoned

in this area (Photo 12). There were two bird baths, a gasoline container and an upended 30-gallon metal drum (Photo 3). One of the bird baths contained liquid which was emitting a urine type malodor.

Ms. Houdek and I then walked eastward where there was a plastic bucket that contained a cloudy liquid . There was a plastic crate that contained several containers of types of cleaners and solvents. There was another gasoline container tipped over in the area. In addition to the aforementioned, I observed an electrical panel, electronic lighting ballasts, a microwave, a fluorescent light fixture and two lead acid batteries open dumped (Photos 14-18). There were also two more waste tires that were on the rim.

At the time I exited the site, there were apparent violations identified in the above Administrative Citation. {End}
