NOTICE OF PROPOSED STIPULATION AND PROPOSAL FOR SETTLEMENT OF ENFORCEMENT CASE

The Attorney General has brought a case against Village of Cave-in-Rock and Maieris Tidy Bowl, Inc. (MTB) for violation of State pollution control regulations. On October 24, 2011, the parties filed a proposed settlement agreement, as to MTB only. The parties agree that a hearing is unnecessary, and in accordance with State law, have requested that the settlement be adopted without holding a public hearing.

Any person desiring that a hearing be held may demand a public hearing in this case by filling a written hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the publication of this notice.
