JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008).

FACTS

- 1. That Loves Park Auto Parts Company is the current owner and operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 9902 North 2nd Street, Rockford, Winnebago County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Rockford/Loves Park Auto Parts.
- That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental
 Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 2010305330.
 - That Respondent has owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- That on October 4, 2011, Donna Shehane of the Illinois Environmental Protection
 Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Rockford Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of

her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 11-17-11, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7004 2510 0001 8588 4508 4 7004 2510 0001 8588 4872.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Donna Shehane during the course of her October 4, 2011 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

(1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in used tires, at this site, not altered, covered or otherwise prevented from accumulating water, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2008).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2008), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>December 15, 2011</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2008), and if the Illinois

Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2008), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2008). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

NARRATIVE INSPECTION REPORT DOCUMENT

On October 4, 2011 I (Donna Shehane) conducted an inspection at Loves Park Auto Parts, located at 9902 North 2nd Street, Rockford, Illinois 61115. Agency records indicate that this facility notified the Illinois EPA of its status as a tire-storage site on January 13, 2011 and paid the annual \$100 fee in February of 2011. The last inspection of this site was conducted on November 29, 2010. However, I conducted a site visit on September 20, 2011 during which photos were taken to assist with documentation of violations during this October 4, 2011 inspection. The weather at the time of this inspection was 69 °F with calm winds and partly cloudy skies.

I arrived on site at approximately 11:45 am and explained the reason for this inspection. I then walked through the salvage yard to the storage area for used or waste tires.

Photo # 1 was taken between two buildings on site. These tires were observed to be in heavy vegetation and some were off-rim. Photos # 2 and # 3 reveal water accumulation in some of the used tires. These used tires are the same as that observed during my site visit on September 20, 2011. Photo # 4 was taken of used tires stored outside in a car body. Photo # 5 shows that there is water accumulation in one of the used tires. This is the same tire as was observed 14 days earlier.

I continued walking to the main storage area where I observed approximately 20 off-rim used tires inside a vehicle body (See photo # 6). Water accumulation was observed inside most of these used tires (See photos # 7, # 8, # 9, and # 10). The used tires in this body were the same used tires as observed on September 20, 2011.

Photo # 11 was taken toward the southeast of a pile of used tires in heavy vegetation. Photo # 12 was taken of additional used tires scattered near the south fence of the site. These used tires are the same as observed on September 20, 2011. Photo # 13 and # 14 were taken of water accumulation in a used tire, the same used tire as viewed 14 days earlier. Photo # 15 was taken of the off-rim used tires in the vehicle body.

Loves Park Auto Parts has been reminded several times of the 14-day time limit for storage of used tires before a method to prevent water accumulation is implemented.

Loves Park Auto Parts facility was found to be out of compliance at the time of this inspection. Apparent violations observed:

- 1. Section 55(a)(4) of the [Illinois] Environmental Protection Act ("Act").
- 2. Section 55(e) of the Act.
- Section 848.202(b)(2) of 35 IAC Subtitle G.
- Section 848.202(b)(5) of 35 IAC Subtitle G.

- 5. Section 848.202(c)(3) of 35 IAC Subtitle G.6. Section 55(k)(1) of the Act.


