Jurisdiction

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2000), and delegated to Ogle County pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/4 (r).

<u>Facts</u>

- That Respondent Rochelle Waste Disposal, LLC, is the present operator of a facility located at 6513 S. Mulford Road, Rochelle, in the County of Ogle, State of Illinois.
- 2. That Respondent, Clyde A. Gelderloos, is the Chief Operator of the above referenced facility.
- 3. That Respondent, City of Rochelle, is the permitted owner of said facility.
- That said facility, Rochelle Municipal Landfill #2, is operated as a sanitary landfill, operating under Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit No. 1994-547-LFM, and designated with Site Code No. 1418030020.
- That Respondents have owned or operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 6. That on March 19, 2003, at 5:10 p.m. a complaint was received by voice mail at the Ogle County solid Waste Management Department (OCSWMD), from a

- concerned citizen stating that there was blown litter outside of the facility and all along the southwestern corner of the site.
- 7. That on March 20, 2003, Stephen J. Rypkema, of the Ogle County Solid Waste Management Department, inspected the above-described landfill facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of such inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Violations

On the basis of direct observation by Stephen J. Rypkema, the County of Ogle has determined that Respondents were conducting a sanitary landfill operation at the above-described facility, which is required to have a permit pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/21(d) (2000), in a manner which resulted in the following violations:

- A. That on March 20, 2003 an on-site inspection of said sanitary landfill facility, and review of Illinois Environmental Protection Agency files and records of said facility, disclosed the following:
 - 1. Refuse in standing or flowing water, in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(o)(1) (2000).
 - Uncovered refuse remaining from a previous operating day, in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(o)(5) (2000).
 - Failure to collect and contain litter from the site by the end of each operating day, in violation of 415 ILCS 5/21(o)(12) (2000).

Civil Penalty

Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4) (2000)., Respondents herein are subject to a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation specified above in

Paragraph A, for a total of one thousand five hundred Dollars (\$1500.00). Additionally, should Respondents elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violations alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by Ogle County and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.

If Respondents acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than July 1, 2063. If Respondents do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against Respondents shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against Respondents.

When payment is made, Respondents check should be made payable to Ogle County Solid Waste Fund and mailed to the Ogle County Treasurer, Ogle County Courthouse, Oregon, IL 61061. Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after adjudicatory hearing, is not paid when due, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency shall take into consideration such failure to pay during any permit review process upon Respondents application for a new permit or for renewal of an existing permit. If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest on such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. Furthermore, if payment is not received when due, the Ogle County State's Attorney shall be requested to initiate

proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest, and hearing costs of Ogle County and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the Ogle County State's Attorney will seek to recover their costs of litigation.

Procedure for Contesting this Administrative Citation

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation, pursuant to and in accordance with 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2000). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, Respondents must file a Petition for Review with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board. A copy of the Petition for Review should be filed with the Ogle County State's Attorney. Such Petition for Review must be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation, or a default judgment shall be entered by the Pollution Control Board. The Petition for Review may be filed with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board at the State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601; and, a copy of said Petition for Review filed with the Ogle County State's Attorney at the Ogle County Courthouse, 110 S. 4th St., Oregon, IL 61061.

General Remarks

A complaint was received a little after 5 p.m. on 3/19/03 by voice mail from a concerned citizen reporting there was blown litter outside the site and all along the southwestern corner of the Rochelle Municipal #2 Landfill. I arrived at about 10:04 a.m on March 20, 2003. I drove to the southwest corner of the site and parked at the leachate storage area. The whole southeastern corner of the site had quite a lot of blown litter, as well as along the ditch and drainage way that exits the site underneath Mulford Road. Some of it was in the bushes and trees. It extended from the SW corner eastward over to where there were three movable litter fences, which were full of litter. From there, the litter was scattered over to the working area. All of it appeared to be from the previous day.

Two people were collecting litter and there were probably 15-20 bags full of litter by the time I arrived there. The winds, upon arrival, were light from the SE, although it was very foggy and calm earlier that morning as reported by the National Weather Service in Rockford. The working face was northeast of the littered area so it was not possible that the blown litter could have accumulated that morning. It all appeared to be wet and to have been there since at least the previous day, if not longer.

Across Mulford Road to the SW of the landfill, there was at least a dozen pieces of litter scattered along the corn field, also along the ditch on Mulford Road. Approaching the landfill from Mulford Road to the North, there were probably a half a dozen pieces of plastic blown into the farm fields on both sides of Mulford Road.

I left the area of the SW corner of the site. I drove into the site and checked in at the scale house. The scale house operator contacted Clyde Gelderloos, he was at a meeting and unavailable. She then contacted Tom Hilbert who said he would meet me in 20 minutes. I then met with Donovan Delegau who came to the scale house and we drove down to the working face. I let him know the litter at the SW corner of the site appeared to me to have been there from the previous operating day and was unacceptable. He admitted the litter was bad and said the winds were strong the previous day and they were unable to get it picked up. But they did have people picking up the litter. He later mentioned that normally they have two guys picking up litter, but one was in court the previous day, so they only had one plus himself and the other equipment operator.

We walked over to the working face and up to the top. I took a look at the area of concern from the top. Obviously there was waste that was uncovered on the south bank of Phase I of Unit II and the litter fences were still scattered with litter from the previous day or more. The waste was scattered all the way to the SW corner of the site where the litter pickers were picking it up.


Conditions were wet that day. Donovan mentioned they were unable to get the litter fences moved to where they would be more effective, because of the wet conditions of the soil. I suggested they use cables or find some other way to drag the fences where they can be more effective. I also suggested they install secondary fencing around the perimeter of the site or hire additional laborers to pick up the litter prior to the end of the operating day. He agreed these were good ideas but said he is limited as to what he can do at the site.

Donovan and I drove back to the scale house and Tom Hilbert arrived. Donovan left, Tom and I drove over to the SW corner where the leachate storage tank is. We looked at the area of concern, I expressed my concern that the litter had not been picked up. He admitted he had been there yesterday afternoon and that he did notice the litter in that area. We talked about the fact that the waste was uncovered. There was some disagreement about what is "uncovered waste".

I mentioned to Tom that I would be writing this inspection report up and discussing it with our enforcement decision group and making a decision. Further action would probably be warranted by these apparent violations.

I drove Tom back to the scale house. I left the site and drove to the corner of Mulford and Creston Roads. I parked and did the narrative of this inspection, and departed at 11:21 a.m.












