<u>JURISDICTION</u>

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That H& M Salvage & Discount Company and Carl Hagler are the current owner and operator ("Respondents") of a facility located at 313 U.S. Highway 51, in rural DuQuoin, Perry County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as DuQuoin/H&M Salvage & Discount Company.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1458115011.
 - 3. That Respondents have owned and operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on December 1, 2011, Maggie Stevenson and Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-

described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Maggie Stevenson and Garrison Gross during the course of the December 1, 2011 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent's caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondent's caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).
- (4) That Respondent's caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in used tires, at this site, not altered, covered or otherwise prevented from accumulating water, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>February 29, 2012</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Subject: Open Dumping / Tire Storage Site Inspection at H & M Salvage & Discount Company

General Remarks: An Open Dumping / Tire Storage Site Inspection was conducted on December 21, 2011, at property owned by H & M Salvage & Discount Company. The Inspection was conducted by Garrison Gross and Maggie Stevenson representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land. The property is located at 313 U.S. Highway 51, in rural DuQuoin, Illinois 62832. The inspection was performed due to the offsite observation of tires stored outside and other open dumped waste items. The inspection began at approximately 12:35 p.m. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were overcast skies, 46° F, with a light breeze. Surface conditions at the site were wet and muddy.

Inspection Findings: While driving South on U.S. Highway 51, we observed several stacks of tires at a warehouse style building. It did not appear to be a retail tire business. As we turned onto the driveway, additional waste items were observed in the wooded area behind the building. We entered the site and attempted to make contact at the warehouse. The door was locked from the outside. I knocked but no one answered the door. We continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site. Evidence of open dumping was observed west of the warehouse (photo 001 and 003-006). Several waste piles were observed. Some of the waste was dumped in standing water. Waste items including but not limited to: tires, box fans, wooden posts, bed frames, furniture, wheels, metal, pallets, and paneling were observed.

Approximately 30 used / waste tires were scattered near the waste piles. Some of the tires were off the rim and had accumulated water. A box trailer that was missing a side door contained approximately 35 used / waste tires (photo 002). Approximately 80 used / waste tires were observed north of the warehouse (photo 010). The tires were barrel stacked and some of them were off the rim and had accumulated water. Approximately 150 used waste tires were observed at the site.

Five (5) waste vehicles were observed at the site. A white van truck (photo 007) and a white Ford cargo truck (photo 012) were not usable in their current condition. The open top dump trailer (photo 008), camping trailer (photo 009), and yellow / white Ford cargo truck (photo 011) did not have current license plates and the overgrowth in vegetation seemed to indicate they had not been used for some time.

Approximately 160 cubic yards of waste were observed at the site. The inspection ended at approximately 12:45 p.m.

Additional Remarks: Information concerning property ownership / control was obtained through tax records from the Supervisor of Assessment's Office in Perry County. The tax bill is mailed to Carl Hagler, H & M Salvage Company, 24390 U.S. Highway 51, Elkville, Illinois 62932. The property is referred to as parcel 1-61-0490-100 and contains approximately 4.0 acres. According to the Secretary of State corporation file detail report, Carl O. Hagler, 313 U.S. Highway 51, DuQuoin, Illinois 62832 is listed as the Registered Agent for the business. Agency records indicate that the facility has not filed a notification / registration form for storage of used / waste tires.






