JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

- 1. That Brian S. Mullins is the current owner ("Respondent") of a facility located at 9552 Market Street, Keensburg, Wabash County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Keensburg/Mullins, Brian S.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1850155002.
 - That Respondent has owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on January 30, 2012, Garrison Gross of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Marion Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 3-21-12, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7009 2830 0001 7496 0537

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Garrison Gross during the course of his January 30, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in open burning, a violation of Section 21(p)(3) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(3)(2010).
- (3) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in Deposition of General Construction or Demolition Debris: or Clean Construction or Demolition Debris a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00)</u>. If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>April 15, 2012</u>, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Subject: Open Dump Site Inspection at Brian S. Mullins Property

General Remarks: An Open Dump Site Inspection was conducted on Monday, January 30, 2012, at the Brian S. Mullins site. The inspection was conducted by Garrison Gross representing the Illinois EPA Bureau of Land. The property is located at 9552 Market Street in Keensburg, Illinois 62852. The inspection was performed as a follow up to a previous inspection conducted on July 26, 2011. Weather conditions at the time of the inspection were sunny skies, 45° F, with a light breeze. Surface conditions were damp to muddy.

<u>Inspection Findings</u>: The inspection began at approximately 9:25 a.m. Two offsite photographs were taken from Main Street (back yard of the property) (photos 001 and 002). Although it appeared that some cleanup had occurred, more than 12 used / waste tires were observed and it appeared that additional open burning had occurred at the site. The inspector entered the site from Market Street. The windows to the residence were boarded up and the door was pad locked from the outside. It appeared that the home was no longer habitable. I continued the inspection by walking and photographing the site.

Remnants of a partially demolished structure remained at the site (photo 003). Demolition wastes including but not limited to: bricks, concrete blocks and insulation were observed. Evidence of continued open burning was observed (now in two locations). Partially burned shingles, insulation, domicile waste and tires beads were observed in the ash (photos 004 – 006). Some landscape waste was present and it appeared that waste had been piled up to burn out a stump. Seventeen (17) used / waste tires were observed at the site. Most of the tires were off the rim and had accumulated water and organic matter (photo 007 and 008). Approximately 15 cubic yards of waste remained at the site. The inspection ended at approximately 9:30 a.m.

Additional Remarks: Information concerning property ownership / control was obtained through tax records from the Supervisor of Assessment's Office in Wabash County. The tax bill is mailed to Brian Mullins, P.O. Box 192 Keensburg, Illinois 62852. The property is referred to as parcel 03-213-09-309-013.








