

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

1. That William Bryant is the current owner ("Respondent") of a facility located on 4.4 acres in the Northern Quarter of Section 15 Township 18 N Range 10 East in Sidney Township, Champaign County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Sidney/B&T Bryant Trucking.
2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0190855011.
3. That Respondent has owned said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
4. That on February 10, 2012, Jennifer O'Hearn of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Champaign Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy

of her inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 4-3-12, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7009 2820 0001 7496 0667.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Jennifer O'Hearn during the course of her February 10, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).

- (2) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris; or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than April 30, 2012, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois

Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Open Dump Re-Inspection Narrative

Site History:

The original inspection of the site was conducted on August 10, 2011 by Jennifer O’Hearn. The site exhibited evidence of open dumping of waste including dimensional lumber, an upholstered cushion, metal, plastic toys, etc. and evidence of storage of waste on semi-trailers including dimensional lumber, a recliner, carpet, etc. The ACWN was sent on September 15, 2011 to B & T Bryant Trucking.

Champaign County Recorder’s and Assessor’s Office

I went to the Champaign County Supervisor of Assessments’ website. The property taxes were paid in the name of William Bryant at the mailing address of 1010 County Road 2125 E., Sidney, Illinois for the property located on 4.04 acres in the Northern Quarter of Section 15 Township 18 N Range 10 East in Sidney Township of Champaign County. The parcel for the property is #24-28-15-100-002.

General Comments:

Jennifer O’Hearn of DLPC/FOS Champaign Regional Office conducted a routine open dump inspection of the above referenced facility on February 10, 2012. This inspection was conducted to determine the regulatory status and evaluate compliance with the Environmental Protection Act (Act) and Title 35 Illinois Administrative Code, Subtitle G: Land Pollution (Regulations). The weather was cloudy, with the temperature around 35 degrees with 5-10 mph winds out of the southwest. Thirty-eight photos and no samples were taken; no one was present to represent the property owner.

The site is located about a quarter mile east of the village of Sidney limits on a commercial property located at 2141 County Road 1000 N. on the south side of the road. Most of the general waste piles are in the southwest portion of the site, with partially buried waste in the south central portion of the site, a pile of clay in the central portion of the site, piles of concrete and asphalt in the east portion of the site, tires in the southwest end and east end of the site, and trailers full of household waste on the west central portion of the site and east end of the site.

I arrived at the site at 10:49 A.M and parked north of the office. I walked up and knocked and no one answered. I then proceeded to walk to the southeast about fifty yards and saw a mattress, a comforter, dimensional lumber, metal, etc. on ground, and an excavator in view further away (photo 1). I turned slightly towards the north, still facing northwest, for a view of dimensional lumber, some painted dimensional lumber, plastic, etc. in with landscape waste, some waste in a pile, some waste along the lip of an apparent fill area (photo 2). I turned slightly further to the northeast now for a view of more waste including, dimensional lumber, foam rubber, plastic, metal, etc. along the lip of the fill area. Also in view was a pile of apparent treated telephone poles further away (photo 3). I stepped to the northwest about twenty-five yards and saw insulation, fiberboard, a lazy-boy recliner, dimensional lumber, general demolition debris, landscape waste, etc. and the mattress as in photo #1 from a view of the opposite side of the waste pile (photo 4). Next I walked around fifteen to twenty yards to the east for view of charred dimensional lumber, other charred material, aluminum siding, etc. on the ground and the low-lying area in between railroad tracks higher area of property (photos 5 & 6). I then walked several yards to the southeast and observed plastic toys and other plastic, a stuffed animal, dimensional lumber, etc. haphazardly scattered on ground (photo 7). Next, I walked a few yards to the northwest for a view of some of the waste in photo #7 along lip of fill edge, at border of higher and lower elevation of land. Sheet metal was also in view sitting on the lower elevation of land at the edge of the fill area (photo 8).

I then walked about a dozen yards to the southeast for a view of dimensional lumber, plywood, black plastic, etc. partially buried. Rusty sheet metal, metal pipe, etc. on other side of metal pile seen in photo #8 was also observed (photo 9). Then I walked to the southeast about twenty yards to see partially buried dimensional lumber and plywood (photo 10). Next I walked to the southeast twenty yards for a view of partially buried dimensional lumber and partially buried painted brick (photo 11). I then hiked to the northwest about fifteen yards to see partially buried dimensional lumber and corrugated black plastic pipe (photo 12). I walked to the south about a dozen yards to view of partially buried dimensional lumber (photo 13). I then walked to the southeast several yards and saw several pieces of partially buried dimensional lumber in front of soil pile (photo 14). I turned to the northeast and saw partially buried painted brick, dimensional lumber, etc. in front of the soil pile (photo 15). I stepped to the northeast ten yards and saw a metal chair leg protruding from ground and partially buried piece of rope (photo 16). I then stepped to the northeast several yards further and saw a partially buried piece of metal pipe (photo 17). Next I walked about ten yards still further to the northeast, entered my vehicle and proceeded to leave the site. (photo 18). I walked to the northeast a dozen yards and viewed rusty metal and plastic. (photo 19).

I then walked twenty yards to the northeast climbing over an asphalt pile and saw shingles, dimensional lumber, demolition debris, concrete block, etc. on top of asphalt pile (photo 20). I climbed several yards to the northeast and saw conduit with wiring, concrete with protruding rebar, etc. in with the concrete pile area (photo 21). I climbed along the concrete piles and

observed an open top trailer with waste visible inside (photo 22). Next I walked to the northwest for almost one hundred yards and saw three off rim tires partially covered in mud, plastic pipe partially buried in a soil pile, etc. (photo 23). I then trudged through the mud about a dozen yards to the southwest and saw a busted up plastic cooler, plywood, etc. on the ground (photo 24). I then stepped a couple yards to the southeast to view a plastic lawn chair and other plastic, rusty metal, dimensional lumber, plywood, etc. on the ground in a pile (photo 26).

After that I stepped a few yards to the northwest for views of the tops of open top trailers with waste including plastic, a mattress, metal, etc. Pallets, dimensional lumber, and three tires were on the ground nearby (photos 27, 28 & 29). Subsequently, I walked forty-five to fifty yards to the southwest and observed water in the form of ice in an off rim tire on the ground (photo 30). Next I walked about ten yards for a view of off rim tires (photo 31). I then walked several yards to the northwest for a view of on rim tires (photo 32). Next I stepped to the northeast several yards and observed two off rim tires with water in the form of ice inside (photo 33). I then walked to the east a couple yards and viewed more off rim tires (photo 34). I then walked forty yards back to my vehicle, stepped in my vehicle and drove to the eastern entrance to the site about seventy-five yards to the east of the western entrance, pulled in and parked. I then exited my vehicle, and walked along County Road 1000 N to the east about 70 yards and then south about 70 yards to view off rim tires in an open topped trailer not covered to prevent accumulation of water (photo 35). I turned and looked to the northwest and saw water in the form of ice in a tire with other tires on the ground behind the trailer (photo 36). I returned 75 yards to the northwest and then viewed the open top trailer with waste including a box springs, metal, plastic, etc. as seen in photo #22 (photo 37). I turned to the southwest for a view of the concrete and asphalt piles (photo 38). I walked about seventy yards to the southwest, entered my vehicle and proceeded to leave the site. I left the site at 12:14 P.M.

In summary, if any waste has left the site since the previous inspection, more waste has been brought in to take its place. None of the five trailers that were full of waste have been emptied and many of the trailers have waste visible that is the same as in the previous inspection. The amount of waste piled up around the site appears to have increased from about 40 cubic yards to 60 cubic yards. Around 20 cubic yards of tires that were not included in the previous inspection were observed at this site in this inspection. Many tires were observed to hold water in the form of ice.

Interview-Bill Bryant, owner of B & T Trucking and property

I called 217/688-3022, the business phone number for B & T Bryant Trucking, on February 27, 2012 and after several attempts in redialing with and without the area code and with and without dialing 1 and receiving the same message that "we're sorry your call can not be completed as dialed", I determined that the number had been disconnected.

Then that same morning I called 217/688-2968, the home phone number listed for Bill Bryant, 1010 CR 2125 E, Sidney, Illinois and received an answering machine. I left a message indicating my phone number and my name, and that I was calling from the Illinois EPA and requesting that Mr. Bryant call me so that we could discuss his property located at 2141 CR 1000N, Sidney, Illinois where I conducted an inspection. I have not yet received a call.

Apparent violations observed during this inspection:

Upon reinspection of the site on February 10, 2012, outstanding violations included:

Environmental Protection Act. 415 ILCS 5/1 et. seq. (formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. Ch. 111 1/2, 1001 et. seq.) {hereinafter called the "Act"}

#1 Pursuant to Section 21(a) of the Act, no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste.

A violation of Section 21(a) is alleged for the following reason: **evidence of open dumping of waste was observed during the inspection.**

#2 Pursuant to Section 21(d)(1) of the Act, no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit

A violation of Section 21(d)(1) is alleged for the following reason: **evidence of the operation of a waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation without a permit was observed during the inspection.**

#3 Pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the Act, no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Pollution Control Board.

A violation of Section 21(d)(2) is alleged for the following reason: **evidence of the operation of a waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of regulations adopted by the Board was observed during the inspection.**

#4 Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the Act, no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage, or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(e) is alleged for the following reason: **waste was stored and/or disposed of at this site which does not meet the requirements of the Act and**

of regulations and standards thereunder.

- #5 Pursuant to Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, no one shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in litter.

A violation of Section 21(p)(1) is alleged for the following reason: **waste was open dumped at this site resulting in litter.**

9. The sale or exchange of parcels or tracts of land existing on July 17, 1959 into no more than two (2) parts and not involving any new streets or easements of access.

The sale of a single lot of less than five (5) acres from a larger tract when a survey is made by a registered surveyor; provided, however, that this exemption shall not apply to the sale of any subsequent lots from the same larger tract of land, as determined by the dimensions and configuration of the larger tract on October 1, 1973.


