

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

FACTS

1. That Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. is the current operator ("Respondent") of a facility located at 4426 N. Prospect Road, Peoria Heights, Peoria County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc.
2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 1434755021.
3. That Respondent has operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
4. That on March 8, 2012 Gerald McGhee, of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 4-10-12, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7009 2820 0001 7496 0841.

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Gerald McGhee during the course of his March 8, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondent has violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondent caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondent is subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). If Respondent elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than May 15, 2012, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed

in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondent fails to petition or elects not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondent's check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondent shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondent from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondent has the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondent elects to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondent shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

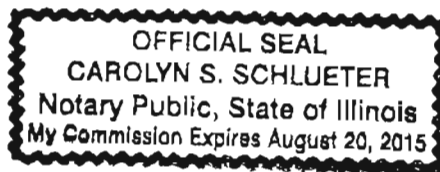

NARRATIVE

On March 8, 2012, I conducted a Tire Storage Inspection from 1:50 p.m. until 2:30 p.m. at Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. located at 4426 N. Prospect Road in Peoria Heights, Illinois. The facility is operated by Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. The facility generates used tires by accepting them in trade for the sale of new motorcycle and trailer tires at retail. The Used and/or Waste Tire Activity Notification Form has been submitted. The required written notice under Section 55.8(a)(3) of the Act was posted.

The inspection was conducted as a follow up to an Administrative Citation Warning Notice sent to the registered agent for Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. on December 15, 2011. A compliance proposal received from Sherry Hayes on behalf of Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. on December 28, 2011 was accepted by the Agency on January 4, 2012. The compliance proposal agreed to take the necessary steps to achieve compliance by March 1, 2012. I interviewed Roger Ritchie, the manager on duty.

Mr. Ritchie produced customer invoices showing that the Illinois Tire User Fee is being charged as a separate and distinct item apart from the selling price. He also produced the same receipts for disposal of used tires by J & R Tire Disposal Service (T7619) that were produced during an inspection conducted on November 11, 2011. Used tires have been on site in excess of 90 days.

I observed approximately 50 used tires for disposal stored inside a green shed. (See photographs 5 and 6).

I observed about 135 used tires stored inside the service building. (See photographs 13 and 14).

I observed an above ground tank marked with the words used oil as seen in photograph 7.

I observed an open dump containing, but not limited to, shipping crates used to transport aquatic vehicles. This open dump was present during an inspection conducted previously on December 13, 2011. (See photographs 8, 9, 10, and 11).

Mr. Ritchie produced receipts dated March 8, 2012 (the same day as this follow up inspection) from Better Earth LHF Compost, Inc. for an unspecified amount of pallets taken for disposal/recycling.

The facility has returned to compliance with apparent violations of Sections 21(p)(2), 55.8(a)(3), 55.9, 55(a)(3) and 55(k)(1) of the Act; and Section 739.122(c) of the Regulations.

The following continuing apparent violations found in a previous inspection conducted on December 13, 2011 and cited in an Administrative Citation Warning Notice dated December 15, 2011 were observed:

1. Pursuant to Section 55.8(b) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.8(b)), a person who accepts used tires for recycling under subsection (a) shall not allow the tires to accumulate for periods of more than 90 days.

A violation of Section 55.8(b) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.8(b)) is alleged for the following reason: **Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. allowed used tires to accumulate for more than 90 days.**

2. Pursuant to Section 21(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(a)), no person shall cause or allow the open dumping of any waste.

A violation of Section 21(a) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(a)) is alleged for the following reason: **Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. caused or allowed the open dumping of waste at the site.**

3. Pursuant to Section 21(d)(2) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(2)), no person shall conduct any waste-storage, waste-treatment, or waste-disposal operation in violation of any regulations or standards adopted by the Board under this Act.

A violation of Section 21(d)(2) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(d)(2)) is alleged for the following reason: **Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. conducted a waste-disposal operation at the site.**

4. Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)), no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)) is alleged for the following reason: **Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. conducted a waste-disposal operation at a site that does not meet the requirements of the Act and regulations thereunder.**

5. Pursuant to Section 21(p)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1)), no person shall, in violation of subdivision (a) of this Section, cause or allow the open dumping of any waste in a manner which results in litter.

The prohibitions specified in this subsection (p) shall be enforceable by the Agency either by administrative citation under Section 31.1 of this Act or as otherwise provided by this Act. The specific prohibitions in this subsection do not limit the power of the Board to establish regulations or standards applicable to open dumping.

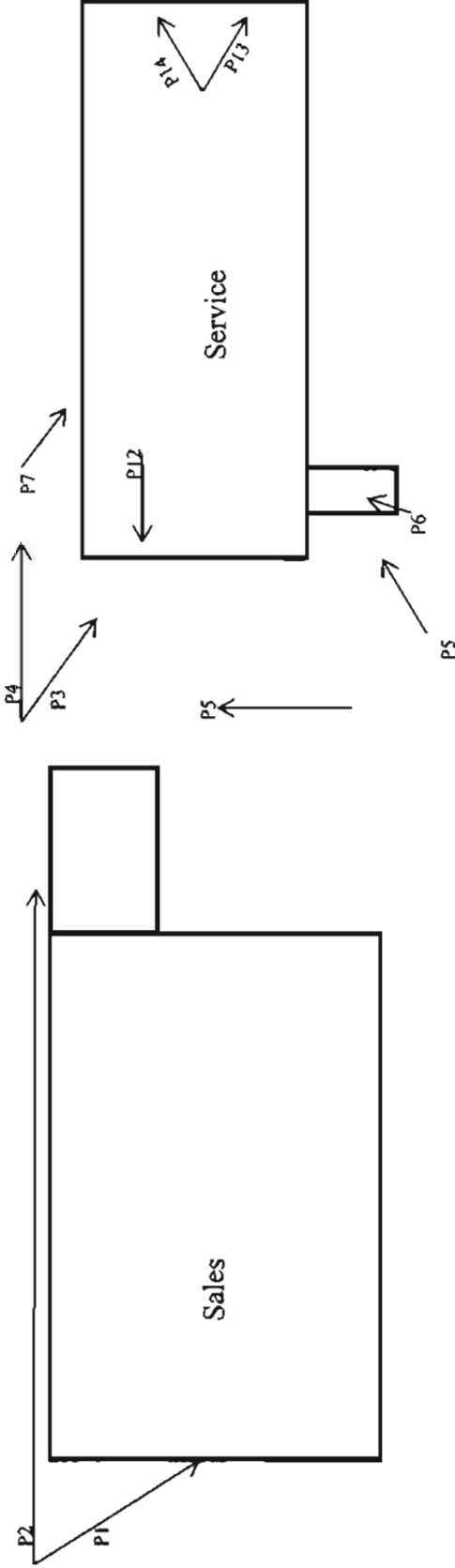
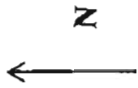
A violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1)) is alleged for the following reason: **Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner which resulted in litter.**

6. Pursuant to Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 815.201, all landfills regulated under this Part shall file an initial facility report with the Agency as specified in this Subpart to provide information concerning location and disposal practices of the facility.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 815.201 is alleged for the following reason: **Grayboy Cycle Center, Inc. failed to file an initial facility report.**

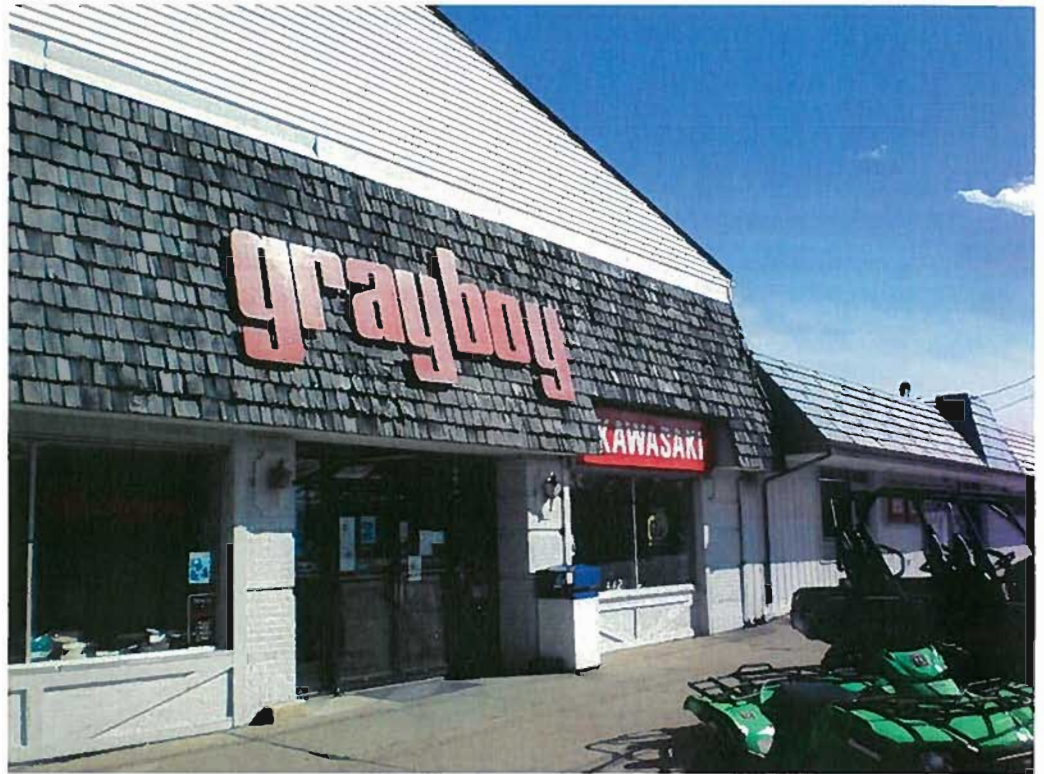

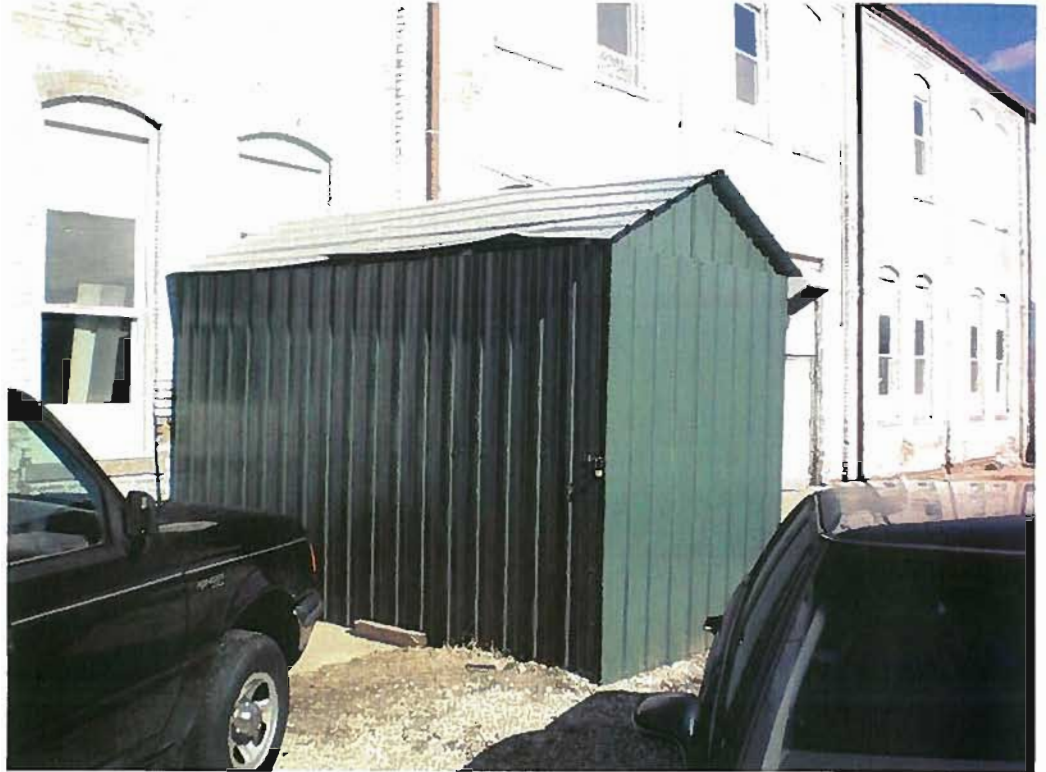


