This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by 415 ILCS 5/31.1, formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, Ch. 111 ½, par. 1031.1, and delegated to the County of LaSalle pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/4 (r), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat., Ch. 111 ½, par. 1004 (r).

FACTS

- 1. That Respondent, Tax Lien Investments, is the present owner and/or operator of property located in Deer Park Township, LaSalle County, Illinois.
- That said facility is an open dump, operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Permit, and designated with Site Code No. 0998055004. Said facility is commonly known to the Agency as the Tax Lien Investments Property
- 3. That the Respondent has owned and/or operated said facility since October 26, 2011.
- 4. That on April 17, 2012, Christy Vargochik, Landfill Inspector, LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Development, under the authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, inspected the above described facility. A copy of the inspection reports setting forth the results of such inspections are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

VIOLATIONS

5. On the basis of direct observations of Christy Vargochik of the LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Development, it has been determined that the Respondents have caused or allowed open dumping at the above described facility in a manner which results in the following occurrences:

That on April 17, 2012, an on-site inspection of said facility disclosed the following:

CIVIL PENALTY

- 6. Pursuant to 415 ILCS 5/42 (b) (4), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat. 1991, ch. 111 ½, par. 1042 (b) (4), Respondent herein is subject to a civil penalty of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) for each violation specified above in Paragraph 5(b) for a total of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00). Additionally, should Respondent elect to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board under the review process described herein below, and if there is a finding of the violation alleged herein, after an ad judicatory hearing, Respondent shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board, in addition to the Fifteen Hundred Dollar (\$1500.00) statutory penalty for each finding of violation.
- 7. If you acknowledge the violations cited herein above, the civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than thirty-five (35) days from the date of service hereof. If you do not petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board of review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of service hereof or if you elect to contest this Administrative Citation, any judgment rendered against you shall specify the due date of the statutory civil penalty and any costs assessed against you.

If any civil penalty imposed by the Illinois Pollution Control Board is not paid within the time prescribed in the order, interest from such penalty will be assessed for the period from the date payment is due until the date payment is received. If any civil penalty, by reason of acknowledgment, default or finding after the ad judicatory hearing is not paid when due, the LaSalle County State's Attorney may initiate proceedings in Circuit Court to collect said civil penalty. In addition to the previously assessed civil penalty, interest and hearing costs of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, if any, the State's Attorney's Office will seek to recover their costs of litigation.

GENERAL REMARKS

Christy Vargochik representing the LaSalle County Department of Environmental Services and Development under the delegated authority of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency performed a solid waste landfill inspection on April 17, 2012. The property is located at northeast corner of Route 71 and Rte 178, Deer Park Township, and Utica, Illinois. At the time of the inspection, the following violations were observed: causing or allowing open dumping; causing or allowing open burning, storing or abandoning waste at a site not meeting the requirements of the Act; causing or allowing the open dumping of any waste at a site that results in litter at the property; and failure to submit an application to operate a landfill.

Weather conditions noted on arrival were sunny and 50 degrees.

The inspection began at 9:00 a.m. I pulled into the parking area, and looked to the east and found overgrown weeds, waste, litter, and the restaurant knocked down (photo 1249.04). I then drove to the south and paused to photograph the demolition debris from the burned out shell of the restaurant (photo 1249.05). I continued to the east, and photographed the open dumped items including cushions, plastics, and other miscellaneous debris (1249.06). At this time, I concluded the inspection, and left the site at 9:15 a.m.
