

Notice of Petition by the Midway RACs, LLC ("LLC") for an Adjusted Standard before the Illinois Pollution Control Board	
<p>On Wednesday, April 11, 2012, the Midway RACs, LLC (hereafter "LLC") filed with the Illinois Pollution Control Board (hereafter "the Board") a Petition for an Adjusted Standard from 35 Ill. Adm. Code § 218.586 (Docket No. AS-2012-003).</p> <p>The LLC, c/o Enterprise Holdings, 600 Corporate Park Drive, St. Louis, MO 63105, will construct and operate a Consolidated Rental Car Facility (hereafter "ConRAC") at Chicago Midway Airport for the purpose of renting automobiles to the general public. Operation of the ConRAC includes the refueling of rental vehicles (hereafter "cars"). At the time of the initial design documentation for the ConRAC in 2002, requirements existed with respect to the installation of Stage II Vapor Recovery Systems for fueling facilities of the nature to be constructed. Such systems were mandated by the Clean Air Act of 1990 to reduce hydrocarbon emissions during refueling of vehicles. At the time, manufacturers of cars were developing "Onboard Refueling Vapor Recovery" (hereafter "ORVR") systems and the Federal Environmental Protection Agency (hereafter "the EPA") anticipated that once "widespread use" of vehicles equipped with ORVR occurred, installation and operation of Stage II Vapor recovery systems would no longer be necessary. In the intervening years, installation of ORVR systems on cars pursuant to requirements of the EPA has progressed to the point such that all new cars are now so equipped. Through the petition, the LLC seeks relief from the requirement for installing and operating the Stage II Vapor Recovery System, citing certain "guidance" documents issued by the EPA in 2006 to the State of Illinois Environmental Protection Agency indicating facilities such as the ConRAC (where 100% of the fleet is equipped with ORVR) have achieved the mandated "widespread use" of such on-board systems, and that such systems provide a higher "in-use" efficiency for capturing fuel vapors during refueling operations than Stage II Vapor Recovery Systems. If granted, the adjusted standard will allow the LLC to eliminate the Stage II System from the current design of the facility and rely entirely upon the ORVR systems installed on the cars to capture vapors released during the refueling process. Any person may cause a public hearing to be held in the above-described adjusted standard proceeding by filing a hearing request with the Illinois Pollution Control Board within 21 days after the date of the publication of this notice. The hearing request should clearly indicate the docket number for the adjusted standard proceeding, as found in this notice, and must be mailed to the Clerk of the Board, Illinois Pollution Control Board, 100 W. Randolph Street, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois, 60601. Pub: 4/18/12 288043</p>	

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
