## ORDER OF THE BOARD (by T.A. Holbrook):

On May 16, 2012, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Heritage Transport, LLC may appeal an April 12, 2012 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206(c), 105.208(a), (c). In the determination, the Agency partially approved a permit to develop and operate a solid waste management facility located at 251 N. Old St. Louis Rd., Wood River, Madison County. The Agency denied a portion of the permit that would have allowed the facility to develop and operate equipment to consolidate household hazardous waste paint and crush paint cans for disposal.

The Board extends the appeal period until August 19, 2012, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.208(a). If Heritage Transport, LLC, fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
