ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):

On May 22, 2012, The Premcor Refining Group, Inc. (Premcor) filed a petition (Pet.) asking the Board to review a January 13, 2012 determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2010); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.206. The Agency determined on January 13, 2012 that it would not approve Premcor's May 2, 2011 submittal, made in response to the Agency's April 1, 2011 letter, entitled "Response Action Plan for Groundwater Inward Gradient Control."<sup>1</sup> The determination concerns an inward gradient control along the western property boundary of Premcor's property in Hartford, Madison County. Until September 27, 2002, Premcor operated a petroleum refinery and distribution center on the site; presently the site does not operate as a refinery, but continues to be actively operated as a distribution center for petroleum products. Pet. at 1-2, and n. 1

On June 21, 2012, the Board issued an order directing the parties to brief a specified, jurisdictional issue. Pursuant to the order, Premcor timely filed a response on July 6, 2012. The scheduled time for the filing of an Agency response was July 23, 2012. On July 20, 2012, Premcor filed a motion to withdraw this petition "as of the date of the motion."

In response to Premcor's motion to withdraw, the Board dismisses the petition and closes the docket.
