MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE REDUCED NUMBER OF COPIES OF RECORD

NOW COMES, Respondent, ILLINOIS ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY, by LISA MADIGAN, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, and moves for leave to file a reduced number of copies of the record of decision for the subject permit. In support thereof, Respondent states as follows:

1. Section 101.302(h) of the Board's Procedural Rules, 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.302 (h), states that the Illinois EPA is to file a signed original and 9 duplicate copies of the record.

2. The record in this matter consists of approximately 900 pages. Due to electronic system constraints, electronic filing of the record is not reasonably possible. Duplication of the record to supply nine hard copies would be time consuming and strain State resources. Respondent requests the Board's consideration of a reduction in the number of copies required.




