### **JURISDICTION**

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010).

#### **FACTS**

- 1. That Colonial Brick Co., Inc. is the current owner and Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Brown Trucking & Ready Mix is the current operator ("collectively Respondents") of a facility located at 308 E. Latimer Street, Abingdon, Knox County, Illinois. The property is commonly known to the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix.
- 2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0950055025.
  - 3. That Respondents have owned/operated said facility at all times pertinent hereto.
- 4. That on December 12, 2012, Gerald McGhee of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's ("Illinois EPA") Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of the inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

5. That on 1-15-13, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7010 2780 0002 1167 5775 - Colonial Bride & Inc. 7010 2780 0002 1167 5768 - Radney Brown VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Gerald McGhee during the course of the December 12, 2012 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2010).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris: or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2010).
- (3) That Respondents caused or allowed water to accumulate in used or waste tires, a violation of Section 55(k)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 55(k)(1) (2010).

#### CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2010), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of <u>Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$4,500.00)</u>. If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than <u>February 28, 2013</u>, unless otherwise provided

by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2010), and if the Illinois Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2010), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondents in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

# PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2010). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondents.

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#### Narrative

On December 12, 2012, I conducted a Tire Storage Inspection from 11:00 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. at Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix located at 308 E. Latimer Street in Abingdon, Illinois. The facility is owned by Colonial Brick Co, Inc. It is operated by Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix. The inspection was conducted as a follow up to an Administrative Citation Warning Notice (ACWN) sent to the owner and operator on August 2, 2012.

I interviewed Rodney N. Brown. Mr. Brown explained that he contacted Liberty Tire Recycling shortly after he called me via/telephone on August 22, 2012 to discuss the suggested resolutions in the (ACWN). Mr. Brown also explained that some of the open dumped waste was pushed into piles after the buildings on site had been destroyed.

I questioned Mr. Brown about the origin of materials such as household waste, waste, E-waste, and furniture. He explained that such materials as household waste, E-waste, and furniture were brought to the site from a remodeling project in Galesburg, Illinois.

I observed about 300 used tires stored in part of a facility building that has collapsed as seen in photograph 1 and 5.

I observed approximately 175 used tires stored under a partially sided structure with a roof as seen in photographs 13, 14, and 15.

I observed about 850 used tires mostly off rims on the ground in a pile next to a remnant wall structure from a facility building. These used tires are not prevented from accumulating water. Many of the tires in the pile contained water/ice. See photographs 2, 6, 7, 18, 19, and 20. Sampling was not conducted.

I observed an open dump consisting of, but not limited to, household waste, landscape waste, construction/demolition debris, automotive waste, plastics, metal, E-waste, and furniture. (See photographs 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 16, 17, and 21).

The following continuing apparent violations were observed:

1. Pursuant to Section 21(k) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(k)), no person shall fail or refuse to pay any fee imposed under this Act.

A violation of Section 21(k) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(k)) is alleged for the following reason: Colonial Brick Co., Inc. as owner and Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix as operator failed to submit the required annual fee.

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2. Pursuant to Section 55(a)(4) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(a)(4)), no person shall cause or allow the operation of a tire storage site except in compliance with Board Regulations.

A violation of Section 55(a)(4) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(a)(4)) is alleged for the following reason: Colonial Brick Co., Inc. as owner and Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix as operator are operating a tire storage site that does not comply with Board Regulations.

3. Pursuant to Section 55(c) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(c)), no person shall fail to file the required notification with the Agency by 1/1/90 or within 30 days of commencement of the storage activity.

A violation of Section 55(c) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(c)) is alleged for the following reason: Colonial Brick Co., Inc. as owner and Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix as operator failed to file the required notification with the Agency.

4. Pursuant to Section 55(d)(1) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55(d)(1)), no person shall cause or allow the operation of a tire storage site which contains more than 50 used tires without meeting the requirements of this Section by January 1 of each year.

- 6. Pursuant to Section 55.6(b) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.6(b)), no person shall failure of the owner or operator of a tire storage site to pay to the Agency an annual fee of \$100.00.

A violation of Section 55.6(b) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/55.6(b)) is alleged for the following reason: Colonial Brick Co., Inc. as owner and

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Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix as operator failed to pay the annual \$100.00 fee.

7. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 848.202(b)(2), accumulations of used or waste tires located outside of any building shall be separated from all buildings, whether on or off site, by 25 feet.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 848.202(b)(2) is alleged for the following reason: Colonial Brick Co., Inc. as owner and Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix as operator are not separating accumulations of used or waste tires 25 feet from buildings on or off site.

8. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 848.202(c)(1), in addition to the requirements set forth in Section 848.202(b), the owner or operator of a site at which more than 500 used or waste tires are located shall maintain a contingency plan which meets the requirements of Section 848.203.

A violation of 35 Ill. Adm. Code 848.202(c)(1) is alleged for the following reason: Colonial Brick Co., Inc. as owner and Rodney N. Brown d/b/a Rod Brown Trucking & Ready Mix as operator do not maintain a contingency plan which meets the requirements of Section 848.203.

9. Pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 848.202(c)(2), in addition to the requirements set forth in Section 848.202(b), the owner or operator of a site at which more than 500 used or waste tires are located shall meet the record keeping and reporting requirements of Part 848 Subpart C.
