On July 8, 1974, Complainants filed their Motion To Dismiss without prejudice the above-captioned cause. It appears that the parties have resolved to their mutual satisfaction the very difficult problems at issue.

Pursuant to negotiations had, the Complainants are of the opinion that Respondents' plan to construct in the future two sewer lines known as Leamington 2-E and Leamington 2-G is the best and most practical manner in which to solve the problems alleged in their Complaint and Amended Complaint.
