OPINION AND ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.K. Zalewski):


On November 20, 2014, the Board denied Southern Illinois Power Cooperative's (SIPC) May 13, 2014 petition for alternate thermal effluent limitations. *See Southern Illinois Power, Cooperative v. IEPA*, PCB 2014-129 (Nov. 20, 2015). Subsequently, the Board discovered an error in the November 20, 2014 opinion and order. Specifically, on page one of the November 20 opinion and order, the Board incorrectly indicated that SIPC's petition failed to demonstrate that the limits imposed by Sections 302.102(b)(8) and 303.331 of the Board's water pollution regulations "are more stringent than necessary to assure the protection and propagation of a balanced and indigenous population of shellfish, fish, and wildlife in and on Lake of Egypt." *Southern Illinois Power, Cooperative v. IEPA*, PCB 2014-129, slip op. at 1. Instead of listing Sections 302.102(b)(8) and 303.331 of the Board's water pollution regulations in that sentence, the opinion and order should have listed Special Condition 4 of SIPC's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit which contained the limitations from which SIPC sought relief.

After considering this error, the Board modifies page 1 of the opinion *nunc pro tunc*, as indicated in the corrected opinion and order dated November 20, 2014 accompanying this order.
