ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Dumelle)

Variance is granted from Rule 203(f) of the Water Pollution Regulations to permit copper levels in excess of 0.02 mg/l subject to the following conditions;

- 1. Treatments with copper sulfate shall be limited to one per month for the months of June through and including September, 1973.
- 2. Dosage with copper sulfate shall not exceed 90 lbs. in Wildwood Lake and 500 lbs. in Northern Oaks Estates per treatment.
- 3. Copper concentrations at the raw water intake to the water treatment plant shall never exceed 1.0 mg/l.
- 4. Copper concentrations in the reservoir shall be measured immediately prior to and after each copper sulfate treatment and the results submitted to the Agency on a monthly basis.
