ORDER OF THE BOARD (by B.K. Carter):

On August 18, 2017, the parties timely filed a joint notice to extend the 35-day period within which Freedom Oil Company may appeal a July 27, 2017, determination of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (Agency). *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2016); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 101.300(b), 105.404(b), 105.406. The determination concerns Freedom Oil Company's underground storage tank (UST) site located at 957 West Reynolds Street in Pontiac, Livingston County. The Agency partially denied Freedom Oil Company's request for reimbursement from the UST Fund.

The Board extends the appeal period until Monday, December 4, 2017, as the parties request. *See* 415 ILCS 5/40(a)(1) (2016); 35 Ill. Adm. Code 105.406. If Freedom Oil Company fails to file an appeal on or before that date, the Board will dismiss this case and close the docket.
