ORDER OF THE BOARD (by C.M. Santos):

On April 23, 2009, Ameren Electric Generating Company; Electric Energy, Inc.; and Midwest Electric Power, Inc. (petitioners) asked the Board to review a March 19, 2009 determination by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA). In that determination, IEPA issued a Clean Air Act Permit Program (CAAPP) renewal permit to the electric generating station owned and operated by Midwest Electric Power, Inc. in Joppa, Massac County.¹ On July 23, 2009, the Board stayed the effectiveness of the contested permit conditions until final resolution of the appeal. On October 16, 2014, the Board granted petitioners' unopposed motion to strike Ameren Electric Generating Company as a party to this appeal.

The parties have reached an agreement about the issues in the appeal, and petitioners received a final modified CAAPP permit issued on August 14, 2017. On September 26, 2017, petitioners filed an unopposed motion for voluntary dismissal of this appeal. The Board grants the motion, dismisses the appeal, and closes the docket.
