

JURISDICTION

This Administrative Citation is issued pursuant to the authority vested in the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency by Section 31.1 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014).

FACTS

1. That Floyd and Vickie Wilson are the present owners of a facility located at 613 Carola Street, Creve Coeur, Fulton County, Illinois. The Respondent Jack Tanner Towing Company hired Parkland Environmental Group, Inc. to demolish an old school building. The Respondent Parkland Environmental Group, Inc. demolished the building and dumped the waste on the Wilson property.
2. That said facility is an open dump operating without an Illinois Environmental Protection Agency Operating Permit and is designated with Site Code No. 0578125003.
3. That on September 13, 2017, Robert Wagner of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Peoria Regional Office inspected the above-described facility. A copy of his inspection report setting forth the results of said inspection is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

4. That on October 25, 2017, Illinois EPA sent this Administrative Citation via Certified Mail No. 7011 1150 0001 0863 5025 - Wilson

VIOLATIONS

Based upon direct observations made by Robert Wagner during his September 13, 2017 inspection of the above-named facility, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency has determined that Respondents have violated the Illinois Environmental Protection Act (hereinafter, the "Act") as follows:

- (1) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in litter, a violation of Section 21(p)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(1) (2014).
- (2) That Respondents caused or allowed the open dumping of waste in a manner resulting in deposition of general construction or demolition debris or clean construction or demolition debris, a violation of Section 21(p)(7) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/21(p)(7) (2014).

CIVIL PENALTY

Pursuant to Section 42(b)(4-5) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/42(b)(4-5) (2014), Respondents are subject to a civil penalty of One Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) for each of the violations identified above, for a total of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). If Respondents elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board, the statutory civil penalty specified above shall be due and payable no later than December 12, 2017, unless otherwise provided by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board.

If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation by petitioning the Illinois Pollution Control Board in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1 (2014), and if the Illinois

Pollution Control Board issues a finding of violation as alleged herein, after an adjudicatory hearing, Respondents shall be assessed the associated hearing costs incurred by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and the Illinois Pollution Control Board. Those hearing costs shall be assessed in addition to the One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500.00) statutory civil penalty for each violation.

Pursuant to Section 31.1(d)(1) of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31.1(d)(1) (2014), if Respondents fail to petition or elect not to petition the Illinois Pollution Control Board for review of this Administrative Citation within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service, the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall adopt a final order, which shall include this Administrative Citation and findings of violation as alleged herein, and shall impose the statutory civil penalty specified above.

When payment is made, Respondents' check shall be made payable to the Illinois Environmental Protection Trust Fund and mailed to the attention of Fiscal Services, Illinois Environmental Protection Agency, 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Along with payment, Respondents shall complete and return the enclosed Remittance Form to ensure proper documentation of payment.

If any civil penalty and/or hearing costs are not paid within the time prescribed by order of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, interest on said penalty and/or hearing costs shall be assessed against the Respondents from the date payment is due up to and including the date that payment is received. The Office of the Illinois Attorney General may be requested to initiate proceedings against Respondent in Circuit Court to collect said penalty and/or hearing costs, plus any interest accrued.

PROCEDURE FOR CONTESTING THIS
ADMINISTRATIVE CITATION

Respondents have the right to contest this Administrative Citation pursuant to and in accordance with Section 31.1 of the Act, 415 ILCS 5/31/1 (2014). If Respondents elect to contest this Administrative Citation, then Respondents shall file a signed Petition for Review, including a Notice of Filing, Certificate of Service, and Notice of Appearance, with the Clerk of the Illinois Pollution Control Board, State of Illinois Center, 100 West Randolph, Suite 11-500, Chicago, Illinois 60601. A copy of said Petition for Review shall be filed with the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency's Division of Legal Counsel at 1021 North Grand Avenue East, P.O. Box 19276, Springfield, Illinois 62794-9276. Section 31.1 of the Act provides that any Petition for Review shall be filed within thirty-five (35) days of the date of service of this Administrative Citation or the Illinois Pollution Control Board shall enter a default judgment against the Respondent.

Narrative

On September 13, 2017, this author (Robert J. Wagner) inspected property owned by Floyd & Vickie Wilson from 1:15 PM to 1:40 PM. See attached property deed. The property is located at 14492 E. Back Rd., Lewistown, Illinois, GPS coordinates 40.322579, -90.166307. For this report, the property will be referred to as the Wilson Property. The inspection was a result of citizen complaints C-2017-099-P and C-2017-100-P.

Complainants allege that Floyd Wilson is allowing contractors to dump illegal fill material on the Wilson Property. The complainants believe that some of the illegal fill is affecting the neighboring properties.

This author arrived at the Wilson Property at 1:15 PM. This author walked and photographed the property. Photographs 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26, and 27 show the following solid waste items: chunks of concrete with no protruding metal bars, red brick, processed wood, electrical conduit, stucco mesh, concrete block, metal debris, a plastic container lid, concrete pavers, plastic sheeting, paper, clothing, plastic debris, sewer pipe, a flip flop, a chunk of concrete with protruding metal bars, a tennis ball, fabric, an anchor bolt, and a wire fence. It appeared that these items were going to be pushed into the adjacent lake.

Photograph 7 shows a daily log for Jack Tanner Towing Company, Inc. Photographs 14, 15, 16, and 17 show a log book for the American River Transportation Co., P.O. Box 1470 Vender #789042, Decatur, Il., 62525. Photograph 25 shows a sign that had DUMP HERE written on it.

This author left the site and drove to Jack Tanner Towing Company, Inc., 802 South 11th Street, Havana, Illinois 62644. This author met with the company president, Daniel Houghton. Mr. Houghton told this author that Parkland Environmental Group, Inc. was hired to demolish an old school building to make way for a new company parking lot. Mr. Houghton paid Parkland \$39,260.00 for the demolition of the building and to have the construction debris taken to the Sangamon Valley Landfill. In the agreement between Parkland and Jack Tanner Towing, demolition debris was to be hauled and disposed of at an EPA waste facility. See attached agreement signed by Daniel Houghton on May 5, 2017. On August 1, 2017, Parkland Environmental Group, Inc. filed a Notification of Demolition and Renovation with the Agency. See attached copy.

This author spoke to Bryan Shepard of Parkland Environmental Group, Inc. by telephone. Mr. Shepard told this author that Mr. Wilson had a sign up along US Route 136 that was soliciting fill. Parkland Environmental Group, Inc. contacted Floyd Wilson and agreed to supply fill material at the Wilson Property. According to Mr. Shepard, a small amount of debris may have gotten mixed in with the "clean fill" that Parkland had provided to Mr. Wilson. This author told Mr. Shepard that the material observed at the Wilson Property did not meet the criteria for Clean Construction Demolition Debris written in Section 3.160 of the Illinois Environmental Protection Act and needed to be taken to an IEPA permitted landfill. Mr. Shepard agreed and told this author the material would be removed immediately.

A violation of Section 21(d)(2) is alleged for the following reason: **Floyd Wilson, Vickie Wilson, Parkland Environmental Group, Inc., and Jack Tanner Towing Company, Inc. conducted a waste-treatment, waste-storage, and waste-disposal operation in violation of regulations adopted by the Illinois Pollution Control Board.**

4. Pursuant to Section 21(e) of the {Illinois} Environmental Protection Act (415 ILCS 5/21(e)), no person shall dispose, treat, store or abandon any waste, or transport any waste into this State for disposal, treatment, storage or abandonment, except at a site or facility which meets the requirements of this Act and of regulations and standards thereunder.

A violation of Section 21(e) is alleged for the following reason: **Floyd Wilson, Vickie Wilson, Parkland Environmental Group, Inc., and Jack Tanner Towing Company, Inc. treated, stored, and disposed of waste at this site which does not meet the requirements of the Act and regulations thereunder.**
