

RECOMMENDATION OF THE ILLINOIS EPA

Now comes the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (“Illinois EPA”) by its attorney, Michelle M. Ryan, and pursuant to 35 Ill. Adm. Code 104.416 provides this Recommendation to the Petition for Adjusted Standard filed in this cause on September 21, 2017. For the reasons that follow, Illinois EPA recommends that the requested modification of adjusted standard be granted.

I. BACKGROUND

Peoria Disposal Company (“PDC”) is a waste management company, which operates a Waste Stabilization Facility (“WSF”) in Peoria, Peoria County, Illinois. Electric arc furnace dust (K061) is treated and stabilized in the WSF. On January 8, 2009, the Pollution Control Board (“Board”) issued an Adjusted Standard (AS 2008-010) with conditions for the treatment of K061 electric arc furnace dust in the WSF.

In this petition, PDC seeks a modification of the order granted by the Board on January 8, 2009, to remove testing for dioxins/furans as a condition of the adjusted standard.


No additional information was provided in the Petition.


