ORDER OF THE BOARD (by Mr. Marder)

This matter comes to the Board on Petition of Galva Foundry Co. for variance from the Air Pollution Control Regulations, Chapter 3 of the Board's Rules and Regulations, for particulates and carbon monoxide during periods of time when installed pollution control equipment malfunctions, to operate two cupolas.

The Petition is inadequate in that it fails to give information as to whether Petitioner has applied for or received a permit to operate during a malfunction or breakdown, as provided for in Rule 105 of Chapter 2 of the Board's Rules and Regulations.

Petitioner also has failed to submit a plan for such emission abatement as may be possible during breakdown of the pollution control equipment.

Petitioner shall file an Amended Petition containing the abovementioned information within 30 days of the entry of this Order. Failure to file such Amended Petition shall cause the Petition for Variance to be dismissed for inadequacy.
